

- **Jesus' wounds have brought us spiritual healing** → "He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed." (1 Peter 2:24 NIV)

Did Jesus REALLY rise from the dead? Yes!

- **Jesus' tomb was carefully sealed to prevent any deception** → "Take a guard," Pilate answered. "Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how." (Matthew 27:65 NIV)
- **Holy angels announced His resurrection** → "The angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.'" (Matthew 28:5-6 NIV)
- **Jesus died for our sins and was raised to make us just in God's sight** → "[Jesus] was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification." (Romans 4:25 NIV)

Is it TRUE that Jesus will come again? Yes!

- **The Almighty God can and will keep His promises** → "Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out--those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. (John 5:28-29 NIV)

- **Jesus will come when most are not expecting Him** → "...the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night." (1 Thessalonians 5:2 NIV)
- **All people will go to one place or the other** → "Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life." (Matthew 25:46 NIV)
- **A person's relationship with Jesus is the deciding factor** → "Whoever believes in him [Jesus] is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son." (John 3:18 NIV)

What Do YOU Think About Jesus?



Are You Aware of YOUR NEED for God's Forgiveness?

Bad News → **Good News** (notice how the *bad news* is canceled out by the *good news*):

- A *sensitive* person came along and said, "I feel for you down there."
- A *practical* person came along and said, "I knew you were going to fall in sooner or later."

The Jesus' Card Questions → with BIBLE Answers!

Who is He? Good man, teacher, prophet, or more! **The Bible – God's Holy Word – teaches that Jesus is much more:**

- **Jesus is the Word of God who was with God in the beginning** → "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." (John 1:1 NIV)
- **Jesus is the One through whom God created all things** → "Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made." (John 1:3 NIV)
- **God told the devil that Jesus would defeat him** → "...I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel." (Genesis 3:15 NIV)

What did He do? Set a good moral example or more! **The Bible teaches that Jesus did much more:**

- **Jesus lived a sinless life** → "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in

every way, just as we are--yet was without sin." (Hebrews 4:15 NIV)

- **Jesus received the sins of the whole world** → "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD [the Father] has laid on him [Jesus] the iniquity of us all." (Isaiah 53:6 NIV)
- **Jesus suffered everyone's eternal punishment** → "He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world." (1 John 2:2 NIV)
- **Jesus laid down His life** → "...I lay down my life--only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again." (John 10:17 NIV)

Were Jesus' life and death for YOUR benefit? Yes!

- **Jesus traded places with us so we could be right in God's sight** → "God [the Father] made him [Jesus] who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Corinthians 5:21 NIV)
- **Jesus gave up heaven and became poor, so that we – through Him – could have the riches of heaven forevermore** → "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich." (2 Corinthians 8:9 NIV)
