B. THE BEGINNINGS: INFANCY OF JOHN THE BAPTIZER AND JESUS THROUGH THE PRESENTATION OF JESUS AT THE JERUSALEM TEMPLE: Luke 1:5—2:39

JOHN IS BORN

Luke 1:57-67

57 Now the time came [was "fulfilled"] for Elizabeth to have her baby, and she gave birth to a <u>son</u>.

58 Her neighbors and relatives heard how the Lord had been unusually kind to her; and they shared her joy.

59 On the <u>eighth day</u> they came to <u>circumcise</u> the baby.

They were going to call him <u>Zacharias</u> because that was his father's name. **60** But his mother spoke up and said, "<u>Not so</u>, he will be named John."

61 "But there is no one among your relatives who has that name," they told her.

62 Then they <u>motioned</u>^{*} to his father to see what name he might want him to have.
63 He asked [signaled] for a writing tablet and wrote the following, "His name is John." They were all surprised.

64 At once Zacharias' speech was restored and he began to speak, praising God.

*Luke 1:20-22: "20 And now, you [Zacharias] will be <u>silent</u> and <u>not</u> able to <u>talk</u> (or <u>hear</u>) until the day this happens, <u>because you did not believe</u> what I said. But it will be fulfilled at the right time."

21 Meanwhile, <u>the people</u> were waiting for Zacharias and were surprised that he was staying so long in the <u>Holy Place</u>. 22 When he did come out, he could not <u>speak</u> to them (nor <u>hear them</u>). Then they realized that he had seen a vision in the Holy Place. He kept <u>motioning</u> to them and remained unable to talk.

65 Everyone who lived around them was overawed. And throughout the <u>hill</u>
<u>country of Judea</u> people kept talking about all these <u>things</u> [things spoken, the miraculous
birth, baby's given name, etc.].
66 All who heard about it thought it over and asked,
"What is this child going to be?" For it was clear that the Lord's hand was with him.
67 His father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit, and he prophesied:

THE *BENEDICTUS* = BLESSING/PRAISE

Luke 1:	68-75: a. Deals with 'the Lord, the God of Israel' (1:68a) AND b. what God has done for Israel— <mark>past, present, future</mark> (1:68b-75)."
68	" <u>Bless</u> / <u>Praise</u> the <u>Lord</u> , the <u>God</u> of Israel <mark>["Yahweh Elōhē Yishrāēl"]</mark> ,
	because He has <u>visited</u> His people,
	and has made redemption/prepared a ransom for them.
69	He has raised up a <mark>Horn<mark>*</mark> of Salvation</mark> for us <u>in the family of His servant David</u> ,
70	as He said long ago through His holy prophets
69 70 71	that He would save us from our enemies
	and from the power of all who hate us ["spiritually"].
72	He wanted to be merciful to our fathers
	and remember His holy covenant, JUSTIFICATION
73	the <u>oath</u> He swore to our father Abraham—
73 74	to rescue us from our enemies
	and to let us serve Him without fear SANCTIFICATION
75	in <u>holiness</u> and <u>righteousness</u> before Him all our life.

• Recall the statement that followed Mary's Magnificat at Luke 1:56: "Mary stayed/abided with Elizabeth about three months and then went back home."

30 The child <u>John</u> grew and became strong in spirit. He lived <u>in the wilderness</u> until he appeared in public before Israel. **(An Essene?)**

*Dr. Just: The Messiah. TLH: "Sun" – 26 times; KJV: "the dayspring from on high hath visited us." <u>Malachi 4:2</u>: "But for you who respect My name there will <u>rise</u> the Sun of Righteousness with healing in <u>His wings</u>."

Compare **<u>Numbers 24:17</u>**: "a **Star** will come from Jacob" (AAT).

The Hebrew term for "sun" is shimshon, the name of the OT hero _____
