Note: Some parts of The Chosen are in the Bible, but other parts are not. This sheet contains a summary of each part of **episode 8** from wikipedia as well as my own comments. *Blessings on reading, watching, and understanding!*

- 1. A businessman and his apprentice (Luke Dimyan) take advantage of land as they negotiate with the owner. // Not in the Bible. The scene does recall the promise of the land made to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, as well as noting some of the sons of Jacob.
- 2. Jesus and Matthew prepare the content of the big sermon. // Not in the Bible. The Sermon on the Mount is written in Matthew chapters 5-7.
- As Tamar joins the group, the disciples continue to bicker amongst themselves. // Not in the Bible.
- 4. The disciples spread the word of the upcoming sermon and plan for its location on the mount. // Not in the Bible. Where did Jesus preach the Sermon on the Mount? This is a possibility: The site known as the Mount of Beatitudes is on the northwestern shore of the Sea of Galilee, between Capernaum and the archeological site of Gennesaret, on the southern slopes of the Korazim Plateau.... Other suggested locations for the Jesus' Sermon on the Mount have included the nearby Mount Arbel, or even the Horns of Hattin.¹
- Shammai (Ric Sarabia), a high-ranking Sanhedrin member and rival of Shimon, is shocked by Shmuel's and Yanni's reports on Jesus. // Not in the Bible. Notice the complaints / charges against Jesus:

- a. Calls Himself the Son of Man (Dan. 7:13).
- b. Claims authority to forgive sins (Matt. 9:6).
- c. Heals on the Sabbath (Mark 3:1-5).
- d. Eats with tax collectors and sinners (Matt. 9:10).
- e. Has women among His followers (Matt. 27:55).

Regarding those complaints / charges
what are your thoughts?

- 6. Jesus discusses with Matthew the sections of the sermon, such as <u>salt and light</u> and <u>light of the world</u>, leading to the <u>Beatitudes</u> as the introduction of the sermon. // The Sermon on the Mount, as recorded in Matthew 5, has this outline in the ESV Bible:
 - a. The Beatitudes
 - b. Salt and Light
 - c. Christ Came to Fulfill the Law
 - d. Anger
 - e. Lust
 - f. Divorce
 - g. Oaths
 - h. Retaliation
 - i. Love Your Enemies

- 7. Thousands arrive on the day of the sermon, including some familiar faces. // Not in the Bible. The Sermon on the Mount begins with these words:
 - a. The setting: NAU Matthew 5:1
 When Jesus saw the crowds, He went up on the mountain; and after He sat down, His disciples came to Him. He opened His mouth and began to teach them, saying,
 - b. The first words: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." (Read the rest of the beatitudes through verse 12, or even the rest of the sermon through chapter 7, on your own.)
- 8. Eden reunites with Simon while Big James and John reunite with their parents, Zebedee and Salome. // Not in the Bible as the crowds gathered, but certainly they did gather; we don't know how many.
- 9. The businessman and his apprentice, who had helped the disciples acquire the sermon's location, arrive as well. // Not in the Bible.
- 10. The apprentice meets the disciples once more and introduces himself as <u>Judas</u> [Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed Jesus]. // The Bible does not tell us how Judas became one of Jesus' followers.
- 11. Jesus walks towards the stage as he begins his <u>Sermon on the Mount</u>. // Jesus will preach through part of the Sermon on the Mount in Season Three,
