- 2. Looked with lust (Matthew 5:28)?
- 3. Stolen anything (Exodus 20:15)?

If you answered, "Yes," Jesus has good news for you! He said: "I have not come to call the righteous [people who think they are good] but sinners to repentance" (Luke 5:32 ESV).

Caution: If you think you are good enough and will be welcomed into heaven because you have *never told a lie, *never looked with lust, or *never stolen anything; then you have been tricked into believing a lie. All have sinned; see Romans 3:10-20; James 2:10; 1 John 1:8, 10.

- Second: He had to take the eternal punishment we deserve, so while He was on His cross God the Father put all the sins of the whole world on Jesus; then He received our eternal punishment.

Right before Jesus laid down His life He said: "It is finished" (John 19:30) or "fulfilled." What does that mean? During Jesus' ministry He explained why He had come: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets [thus the Old
