- 1. A Partridge in a Pear Tree = Christ, the Son of God We celebrate His birthday on December 25, the first day of Christmas! In the song, Christ is symbolically presented as a mother partridge, the bird that is willing to give its life to protect its young. Jesus said of Jerusalem: NIV Luke 13:34 "...how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!"
- 2. **Two Turtle Doves** = Old and New Testaments They both tell us about God's creation, people's sin, God's love, Jesus' saving work, and Jesus' promised return!
- 3. Three French Hens = Faith, Hope, and Love (1 Corinthians 13:13).
- 4. **Four Calling Birds** = <u>Gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, John</u> They proclaim the Good News of Jesus conception, birth, life, death, resurrection, ascension, and return!
- 5. **Five Golden Rings** = Torah or Pentateuch Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy The first five Books of the OT, containing creation, marriage, the fall, Christ, sacrifice, flood, languages, and a people through whom the Savior would come!
- 6. Six Geese-a-Laying = Six Days of Creation God made us, loves us, sustains us, and saved us; therefore, He is worthy of our love, trust, honor, obedience, and praise (Genesis 1, Exodus 20:11).
- 7. **Seven Swans-a-Swimming** = <u>Seven Gifts of the Spirit</u> They are prophesying, serving, teaching, encouraging, contributing, leadership, mercy (Romans 12:6-8).
- 8. **Eight Maids-a-Milking** = **Eight Beatitudes** Blessed are \*the poor in spirit, \*those who mourn, \*the meek, \*those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, \*the merciful, \*the pure in heart, \*the peacemakers, \*those who are persecuted because of righteousness (Matthew 5:3-10).
- 9. Nine Ladies Waiting/Dancing = Nine Fruits of the Spirit They are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control (Galatians 5:22-23).
- 10. **Ten Lords-a-Leaping** = **Ten Commandments** (Exodus 20; Deut. 5).
- 11. Eleven Pipers Piping = Eleven Faithful Disciples Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Simon the Zealot, Judas son of James (Luke 6:14-16; 24:9, 33).
- 12. Twelve Drummers Drumming = 12 Points of Belief in the Apostles' Creed I believe... (1) in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. (2) in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. (3) He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. (4) He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried, and descended into hell. (5) on the third day He rose again from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. (6) He will come to judge the living and the dead. (7) in the Holy Spirit. (8) in the holy Christian Church. (9) in the communion of saints. (10) in the forgiveness of sins. (11) in the resurrection of the body. (12) in the life everlasting. Amen!
