## Sexual Expectations

- 35. One of God's purposes for sex within a marriage: To avoid sexual temptations: "The husband should fulfill his marital duty to his wife, and likewise the wife to her husband. The wife's body does not belong to her alone but also to her husband. In the same way, the husband's body does not belong to him alone but also to his wife. Do not deprive each other except by mutual consent and for a time, so that you may devote yourselves to prayer. Then come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control." (NIV 1 Cor. 7:3-5)
- 36. One of God's purposes for sex within a marriage: To have children: "God blessed them and said to them, 'Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it." (Gen. 1:28 NIV)
- 37. Realize this sexual difference between men and women: Men tend to operate like microwaves – getting ready very quickly, while women tend to be like crock pots aetting ready over a longer period of time: therefore, women tend to enjoy being romanced, which is not important to most
- 38. Don't unknowing abort your children: If you have the ability to get pregnant and do not currently desire children, consult your doctor to choose a birth control method that will not allow conception to occur.

## Communication

- 12. Practice this communication advice:
  - a. Disagree Yes (okay)!
  - b. Disrespect No (not good)!
- 13. Practice this communication advice:
  - c. Avoid using "You" It accuses the other person and leads to conflict.
  - d. Try using "I" It expresses your feelings and leads to unity.
- 14. **Do this:** Give your spouse a special card which expresses your true feelings!
- 15. **Do this:** Compliment your spouse at least once each day!

#### **Conflict Resolution**

- 16. Whenever you forgive your spouse, promise the following:
  - a. I will not bring this sin up to use it against you!

- b. I will not bring this sin up to others!
- c. I will not dwell on this sin!
- d. I will not let this sin hurt our relationship!
- 17. Whenever your spouse needs your forgiveness: Remember that God freely forgave you as a gift! Then give that same gift to your spouse!
- 18. Whenever you feel this way toward your spouse: "You hurt me, so I'm going to hurt you!" Let us remember who we are in Christ; then have this attitude: "You hurt me, but I forgive you!" Jesus said: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you ..." (NIV Matthew 5:44)
- 19. Forgiveness provides a fresh start! No matter how a husband and a wife have hurt each other, forgiveness wipes the slate clean, thus provides a fresh start! "If we confess our sins, [God] is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (NAS 1 John 1:9)
- 20. Let your spouse know of your willingness to forgive! Such knowledge will encourage 
  ◆openness, ◆confession, and ◆closeness.
- 21. **Stop living in the past!** Forgive and do your best to forget; then focus on the present and the future!
- 22. **Keep your suitcase empty!** With every issue, even past unresolved issues, work through these steps: <u>regret</u>, <u>repentance</u>, <u>confession</u>, and <u>forgiveness!</u> If you need marriage help, contact Pastor.
- 23. Understand and Apply God's Word: "In your anger do not sin, Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold." (NIV Ephesians 4:26-27) Therefore, forgive quickly so that the devil has no opportunity to hurt your relationship!

24. **Apply this verse:** NAS **Matthew 7:12** "...however you want people to treat you, so treat them..."

## Financial Management

- 25. His, mine, or ours: It's important to combine your resources as well as your bills. Take this attitude: With OUR money we will pay OUR bills!
- 26. **Set a spending limit:** Agree on an amount that either of you can spend without asking the other person, which gives limited freedom! Anything over the set amount must be discussed and agreed upon.
- 27. Apply this verse: NIV 1 Timothy 6:10 "For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs."
- 28. Christian couples live the Bible: NAS Proverbs 3:9 "Honor the LORD from your wealth, And from the first of all your produce..." We honor the Lord by giving to Him FIRST!

  16:17 "Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the LORD your God has blessed you." Base GIVING on RECEIVING!
- 30. Christian couples live the Bible: NIV Malachi
  3:8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me.
  "But you ask, 'How do we rob you?' "In
  tithes and offerings." Since the tithe belongs
  to the Lord, we rob Him whenever we do not
  give a tithe from whatever we receive!
