24. T F Eternal salvation is simple.

John 6:47 [Jesus said:] "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life."

25. T F God wants you to *know for sure* about your entrance into heaven.

1 John 5:12-13 He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life.

26. T F Trusting in Christ Jesus for eternal life will certainly *change* your life.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

27. T F Through faith in Jesus, you are a child of God and He is your heavenly Father.

1 John 3:1 See how great a love the Father has bestowed upon us, that we should be called children of God; and *such* we are.

28. T F Christians live for Christ, because He lived and died for them.

2 Corinthians 5:15 ...and He died for all, that they who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf. **Galatians 2:20** ...the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me.

29. T F Christians, by grace, trust in Jesus for eternal life and want to do His will.

John 15:6 [Jesus said:] "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned."

Revelation 14:11 And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; and they have no rest day and night...

31. T F The Bible will *greatly benefit* all who *continue* to read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest it.

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success. Psalm 1:1-3 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked. Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers! But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night. And he will be like a tree firmly planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season, And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers.
