7. <u>MYTH</u>: I have sinned *so much* that God will never let me into heaven.

TRUTH: "...do you not know that the unrighteous [those without sorrow for their sins and without faith in Jesus as their Savior] shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And such were [past tense] some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, **but** you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God" (1 Cor. 6:9-11 NAS) "If we confess our sins, [God] is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9 ESV).

8. **<u>MYTH</u>**: No one can ever *know for sure* about his/her entrance into heaven.

TRUTH: "And this is the testimony, that **God** gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to **you** who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may **know** that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:11-13 ESV).

MYTH: Whenever I have to make a decision, I should do what I think is best.

TRUTH: "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and <u>do not lean on your own</u> <u>understanding</u>. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6 ESV).

Some Are Far Away from the Truth

Some believe there is no God – so they believe in the big bang and evolution, they also reject the reality of an eternity and any need for a Savior. If that is your situation, I kindly urge you to *think about this brochure, *evaluate your source of truth (is it really reliable), *realize that absolute truth comes from God, and *repent (thus acknowledge God's truth the Bible, be sorry—wherever you are living in opposition, and receive Jesus—as the One in whom you are trusting for eternal life)!

- <u>Good news Jesus said</u>: "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. <u>I have not come to</u> <u>call the righteous but sinners to</u> <u>repentance</u>" (Luke 5:31-32 ESV).
- "<u>Repent</u> [be sorry for your sins] ... and turn again [to Jesus as your Savior], that your sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord" (Acts 3:19-20 ESV).

Introduction

Today's world is filled with information; we receive it through many modes, including books, newspapers, magazines, radios, phones, TVs, and computers. So the challenge today is not *obtaining* information, but *sorting* the information into two categories: **myth** and **truth**. For example:

- MYTH: You must wait 24-hours before filing a missing person's report.
 TRUTH: The police will accept it sooner.
- MYTH: Don't eat; then swim.
 TRUTH: Eating only makes a person short of breath; it does not cause cramps.

- MYTH: People evolved from chimpanzees.
 TRUTH: God created chimpanzees and people on day 6 of creation (Gen. 1:26-27).
- MYTH: Jesus was born on December 25.
 TRUTH: The early church transformed a pagan celebration of *daylight* into a Christian celebration of *the True Light*, the Son of God, coming into the World.
- + MYTH: There were definitely three wise men.

TRUTH: The Bible never says how many.

Sometimes *the truth* is interesting, but sometimes *the truth* makes the difference between *eternal life* and *eternal condemnation*.

- Jesus prayed to the Father: "...<u>your word</u> <u>is truth</u>" (John 17:17 ESV).
- Jesus said to people who had believed in Him: "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and <u>the truth will set you free</u>" (John 8:31-32 ESV).

But why should we trust the Bible to be *the truth*? Please see the next section!

The Bible Is the Truth

Many claim to have *the truth,* so how can we know for sure? These are some of the many reasons why we *can* and *should* be confident that the Bible is God's Word of Truth:

- <u>Prophecy in General</u> God declared over 2,000 things in advance; then they happened, *just as He said!*
- <u>Prophecy about Jesus</u> God declared over 300 things in advance about the Promised Savior; *then they came to fulfillment during His earthly life!*
- <u>Science</u> Even though evolutionists

claim to be on the side of science, *honest science* agrees with the Biblical account of creation!

- <u>The Four Gospels</u> They are not *identical* but *similar*; in a courtroom, "identical" testimony points to fabrication while "similar" testimony points to the truth!
- <u>The Bible Itself</u> Many in the Bible, who laid down their lives for the truth of the Bible, claim that it is the truth!

MYTH or **TRUTH**

Are YOU Certain about YOUR Eternity?



Sometimes things can *look* or *feel* or *seem* so right, but are they? The Bible says: "There is a way that <u>seems right</u> to a man, but its end is <u>the way to death</u>" (Proverbs 14:12 ESV). Since we *cannot* trust our feelings, how can we *distinguish* between **a myth** and **the truth**? Regarding eternity, *God has told us the truth in His Holy Word, the Bible*!

As you read through this section, notice that each part has two opposites – *a myth and a truth*; then, *by God's grace*, may you *push away* the myth and *embrace* the truth!

1. **<u>MYTH</u>**: I am good enough to go to heaven.

TRUTH: "None is righteous, no, not one..." (Romans 3:10 ESV). Therefore, no one, *of himself*, can be righteous, thus sinless, holy, or perfect, in God's sight! 2. <u>MYTH</u>: Since I haven't done anything *real* bad, God will let me into heaven.

TRUTH: "...whoever keeps the whole law and yet <u>stumbles in one point</u>, he has become <u>guilty of all</u>" (James 2:10 NAS).

3. <u>MYTH</u>: Since God is a loving God, no one will be eternally condemned.

TRUTH: "Whoever believes in [Jesus] is not condemned, but <u>whoever does not</u> <u>believe is condemned already</u>, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God" (John 3:18 ESV).

4. **<u>MYTH</u>**: Since others think well of me, I will be welcomed into heaven.

TRUTH: What *God knows* is what counts. Jesus said: "I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead" (Revelation 3:1 ESV).

5. <u>MYTH</u>: I have done *more good* than bad, so I'm in good shape with God.

TRUTH: No amount of good can meet God's requirement. Jesus said: "You ... must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect" (Matthew 5:48 ESV).

6. <u>MYTH</u>: Since I go to church, I will also go to heaven.

TRUTH: We must be clothed in Christ: "...when the king came in to look at the guests, he saw there a man who had no wedding garment [thus he was not clothed in Christ, Galatians 3:27]. And he said to him, 'Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. Then the king said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot and cast him into the outer darkness.'" (Matthew 22:11-13 ESV).
