You Are Here – Part 6 The Rise of Judaism: –) We Can Save Ourselves!

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ, last Sunday we focused on the OT animal sacrifices; the LORD instituted them to point to → the horror of sin AND → the coming Savior! Think about this: The LORD told the people: • do a particular thing • for a particular reason, which points to a particular reality! So what happened? Some kept • seeing their sin, • sacrificing animals, and • longing for the Promised Messiah! However, as time went on, others continued the rituals but forgot the reason WHY! The "some" trusted in the Savior, while the "others" trusted in their keeping of the rituals. Today is similar: Some trust in Jesus, while many trust in themselves! This sermon includes a broad look at the religion of Judaism.

- 1. WHEN Did Judaism Begin? Its members point to the time of Abraham, but they do not understand that the FIRST religion of the Jews (of Abraham) was Christianity (Rev. 2:9; 3:9). So Judaism arose LATER as a falsification of Christianity; NOTE: the Christ was promised in Eden!
- 2. Follow-Through, BUT NO FAITH: Abraham had faith (Gen. 15:6), but some after him had only rituals. These passages jump ahead about 1,300 to 1,400 years:

- a. The LORD said: ^{NAS} Amos 5:21 "I hate, I reject your festivals, Nor do I delight in your solemn assemblies. ²² Even though you offer up to Me burnt offerings..., I will not accept *them*..." Martin Luther wrote: "The wicked do not please the LORD, regardless of how great and splendid their works may be." (LSB, 1465)
- b. ^{NAS} Isaiah 1:11 "What are your multiplied sacrifices to Me?" Says the LORD. "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams, And the fat of fed cattle. And I take no pleasure in the blood of bulls, lambs, or goats." Why did the LORD give that response to the doing His commands? "They claimed to worship God at the same time they violated His laws." (LSB, 1088-1989)
- c. The LORD said: ^{NAS} Isaiah 66:3 "...he who kills an ox is *like* one who slays a man; He who sacrifices a lamb is *like* the one who breaks a dog's neck; He who offers a grain offering *is like one who offers* swine's blood..." <u>WHY</u>? "The use of prescribed offerings...as a magical device to immobilize the Lord is as abhorrent to Him as sacrificing human beings or unclean animals..." (LSB, 1199)
- Judaism at Jesus' Time: We now focus on the Pharisees – an important religious group in Jesus' time which followed the Oral Law (a legal commentary on the Torah) in addition to the Torah (the first five books of the OT) and attempted to live in a constant state of purity. Faith was completely gone; they trusted in their works!
 - a. John chapter 8:12-59 is an argument of sorts between the Pharisees and Jesus: Jesus said to

them: ¹²"I am the light of the world..." but they basically called Him a liar. Later Jesus said to them: ³⁷ "I know that you are Abraham's offspring; yet you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you....³⁹ They answered... "Abraham is our father." ... ⁴¹ "...we have one Father, even God." ⁴² Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me...⁴⁴ "You are of *your* father the devil..." Then, later, they said to Jesus: ⁵³ "Surely You are not greater than our father Abraham, who died? ... ⁵⁴ Jesus answered...⁵⁶ "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad." ⁵⁷ The Jews therefore said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." ⁵⁹ Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself, and went out of the temple.

- b. Jesus—to the Pharisees: ^{NAS} Mark 7:6 ... "Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites [people who falsely profess a relationship with God], as it is written, 'This people honors Me with their lips [outward], But their heart [inward] is far away from Me.⁷ But in vain [uselessness] do they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the precepts of men [teaching the rules of men as if they were from God].'⁸ Neglecting the commandment of God [what He taught], you hold to the tradition of men [what you makeup]."
- 4. Judaism Today: The ninth largest religion in the world.¹

- a. <u>How many</u>? Worldwide there are about 13 million 5.7 million in Israel, 5.2 million in the USA (with 1.9 million of those in New York City).²
- <u>All three types have three things in common</u>: They *reject the doctrine of the Trinity, *reject original sin, and *believe that "the ultimate aim of history is the perfection of humanity through the unfolding of the divine power in man."
 - i. **Orthodox** "there is no way to God except through loyalty to the divine laws."
 - ii. **Progressive** they deny "the absolutely binding character of the Torah."³ Basically they are the same as liberal theology.
 - iii. Conservative In between the other two.
- c. <u>Did you notice the important things that are</u> <u>missing in Judaism</u>? Admitting they are sinners who need the Promised Savior! Think about *the first sin, *the promise of the Savior, *the worldwide flood, and *the blood sacrifices; all that are most important for truth and salvation are completely gone from Judaism. How sad!

Conclusion: It's not just those in Judaism who are missing the truth, *it is most people in today's world*! So let us \rightarrow see our sins, \rightarrow rejoice in the Christ, and \rightarrow kindly tell others how much God loves us! And all God's people said: *Amen*!
