Therefore, this year, we will consider four perspectives – those of **†**God the Father, **†**Mary, **†**Elizabeth, and **†**Joseph.



Sermon: The Perspective of Mary! Based on Luke 1:26-38 NET

L = Leader \bullet C = Congregation \bullet A = All Today's service is Vespers (Adapted from Lutheran Service Book, 229-234).

PREPARATION:

²⁶ In the sixth month God sent the angel Gabriel to a town in Galilee called Nazareth. ²⁷ to a virgin engaged to a man by the name of Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ When the angel entered her home, he said, "Greetings, you who are greatly blessed. The Lord is with you." ²⁹ She was startled by what he said and tried to figure out what such a greeting might mean. ³⁰ The angel told her, "Stop being afraid, Mary. God has chosen to bless you. ³¹ You see: You will conceive and give birth to a Son, and you will name Him JESUS; ³² He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give Him the throne of His ancestor David; ³³ He will be King over the people of Jacob forever, and His Kingdom will never end."

³⁴ Mary asked the angel, "How can this be? I have had no relations *[sexual relations]* with a man." ³⁵ The angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come over you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. And for that reason the Holy Being to be born <of you> will be called the Son of God. ³⁶ Also consider the fact that even Elizabeth, your relative, has conceived a son in her old age. People call her childless, but she is now in her sixth month. ³⁷ There is nothing that God will not be able to do." ³⁸ "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "Let it happen to me as you said." Then the angel left her.
