# What Was the Perspective of the Centurion on Jesus?

#### Introduction: Dear friends in Jesus Christ:

Today we focus on the <u>Roman centurion</u>, the man who had one hundred soldiers under his command and was authorized to crucify Jesus – thus to *nail Him to a cross* and *keep Him there until He was dead!* 

That centurion  $\Rightarrow$ <u>heard</u> what Jesus said from the cross,  $\Rightarrow$ <u>experienced</u> the darkness from noon until 3:00,  $\Rightarrow$ <u>saw</u> Jesus lay down His life, and  $\Rightarrow$ <u>felt</u> the earthquake; then he confessed: "Truly, this man was the Son of God."

#### 1. Why that conclusion?

- a. Jesus' crucifixion... *He willingly stretched out His hands!*
- b. Jesus' prayer for forgiveness... *Father, forgive them...*
- c. Jesus' care for His mother... Asking John to care for her as his own mother!
- d. Jesus' promise to the criminal... *Today you will be with me in paradise!*

e. Jesus' laying down of His life... *No one took it from Him, but, when His work was done, He laid it down!* 

### 2. Why do we need the Son of God?

- a. We cannot save ourselves... We are unholy and we have no ability to make ourselves holy!
- b. We need the God-Man:
  - i. He lived without sin in our place!
  - ii. He bore our punishment!
  - iii. He opened heaven!

### 3. Let us repent and believe:

- a. We all deserve hell, so let us be sorry!
- b. Jesus is the only way for everyone, *so let us believe in Him as OUR only way to heaven!*

## Conclusion: Let us pray:

Dear Father in heaven, though we deserve Your wrath, You gave us Your Son; though we deserve punishment, You offer us the gift of forgiveness; though we deserve eternal banishment from You, You offer us eternal bliss in Your glorious presence!

Therefore, move us to ♦sincere sorrow, ♦true faith, and ♦much gratitude—for Your gift of life and heaven through Jesus! In His name, we pray...
