Luke 21:29-36 ESV

Watch and Pray!

Sunday, November 24 at 8:00 & 10:45 Last Sunday of the Church Year – 2013

Our Weekday Services now switch to Wednesdays as follows: Thanksgiving Eve at 7 PM; Midweek Advent at 11 & 7 on 12/4, 11, 18

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: As we move *closer and closer* to Jesus' return, so the temptation is growing *stronger and stronger* for us to \rightarrow stop being faithful, \rightarrow drop our guard, \rightarrow become complacent, and \rightarrow go the way of the world! Therefore, Jesus' spoke these loving words of instruction and warning:

- 1. Be Aware of the Time: ²⁹ And he [Jesus] told them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees. ³⁰ As soon as they come out in leaf, you see for yourselves and know that the summer is already near. ³¹ So also [you], when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near." //
 - a. <u>Summer</u>: We know the seasons in northern Ohio; now it is **fall**—when the trees shed their *leaves*; soon it will be **winter**—when the trees are without leaves; then it will be **spring**—when the trees bud and burst forth with leaves. When that happens, we know that **summer** is near!
 - b. <u>The Fullness of God's kingdom</u>: As the evidence in nature helps us identify the season, so the evidence in our world – wars, great earthquakes, famines, and pestilences – helps us identify the nearness of Jesus' return. Even though many

may be gripped by fear, we – through Jesus – can
rest in peace and
be filled with joy because
+He is in control, +He is our Savior, and, soon,
+He will rescue us from this sin-filled world!

- Realize that Some Things Will Continue: ³² "Truly, I say to you, this generation will [surely] not pass away until all has taken place. ³³ [The] heaven and [the] earth will pass away, but my words will [surely] not pass away." //
 - a. <u>This generation</u>: What did Jesus mean? Dr. Kretzmann wrote "that this generation, the race of the Jews...will not lose its identity as a separate race, but retain its characteristics among the nations..., in spite of all persecutions, until the end of time..." (NT: I:382) Think about some of the factors that have stood against the Jews: •the loss of their land and many lives in the year 70, •having no land for nearly 1900 years, and •the holocaust, yet, *just as Jesus promised*, so they still continue to this day!
 - b. <u>My words</u>: Jesus wants us to know that His words are *more significant* and *longer lasting* than even heaven and earth! Isaiah wrote: "The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever." (40:8 NAS) Therefore, when today's world pushes the idea of *GOING GREEN* to save the earth, let us push the idea *GOD'S TRUTH* to save souls! Dr. Kreztmann wrote: "...in the midst of the destruction of worlds and the very universe itself, the Word of

the Lord will stand in eternity as a rock of trust and confidence for all believers." (Ibid.)

- 3. Don't Become Complacent: ³⁴ "But watch [pay attention, give heed to] yourselves lest your hearts be weighed down [burdened] with dissipation [indulging in the pleasures of life to your harm] and drunkenness and cares [anxieties, worries] of this life, and that day come upon you suddenly like a trap. ³⁵ For it will come upon all who dwell on the face of the whole earth." //
 - a. "But watch yourselves..."That is the OPPOSITE of many who say: If it feels good—do it; if it tastes good—eat it; if the path is easier—follow it! But for those who know Jesus, we are called to pay attention to →God's Word, →the signs pointing to Jesus' return, and →the many traps that have been laid for the purpose of catching us and ripping us away from our Savior!
 - b. Regarding *gluttony* and *drunkenness*, Dr.
 Kretzmann warns us that such behavior "makes the Christian unfit for the battle with the powers of darkness." (Ibid.)
 - c. Regarding the cares of this life and our worries about the future, they threaten "to fill our hearts and to drive out all trust in the Lord and His gracious providence. Where care becomes supreme, there faith cannot exist." (Ibid.)
 - d. As an animal trap catches unsuspecting animals, so Jesus' return will catch many who are unrepentant, thus without sorrow for their sins and without faith in Jesus as their Savior!

- 4. Fully Rely On God: ³⁶ "But stay awake [be alert, keep watch] at all times, praying [asking, begging] that you may have strength to escape [flee away from] all these things that are going to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man." //
 - a. Since Jesus loves us He urges us to +keep on watching between the Word and the events in the world and +keep on praying that the LORD will give us the strength to *endure all that is to come and *stand in faith before our Savior!
 - b. "For...unbelievers He will come as a Judge and punish them as His own enemies.... But for the believers...He will come as their Savior." (Ibid.)

Conclusion: At the present time, when many are going the way of the world, may the LORD enable us to **†**see our sin, **†**rejoice in His forgiveness, **†**be instructed by the Word, **†**be strengthened by the Spirit, and **†**be ever-ready for Jesus glorious return!
