Psalm 136:1-26 ESV

His Steadfast Love Endures Forever

Wednesday, November 22 at 7 PM

The Eve of our National Day of Thanksgiving – 2017

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: On this eve of our national day of thanksgiving, we focus on Psalm 136. The Psalm declares
the greatness of our God and some of His countless mighty acts. We are also reminded 26 times in the Psalm that His steadfast love endures forever.

As we work our way through the Psalm, let us ♦be in awe of our Great God and ♦give thanks for His ever-enduring love!

The God of gods: Let us give Him thanks!

- ¹ Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever. // Think about the LORD God Almighty: He is not bad but good; furthermore, His love endures forever, so let us give Him thanks!
- ² Give thanks to the God of gods, for his steadfast love endures forever. // Our God is the creator and ruler of the universe; He is far above every so-called god, *so let us give Him thanks!*
- 3. ³ Give thanks to the Lord of lords, for his steadfast love endures forever; // Our LORD is the Master of the Universe; He is infinitely greater than everyone, *so let us give Him thanks!*

Wonders of Creation: Genesis 1

- 4. ⁴ to him who alone does great wonders, for his steadfast love endures forever; // A good illusionist can create an illusion of a great wonder, but the LORD alone is the One who does countless great and actual wonders!
- 5. ⁵ to him who by understanding made the heavens, for his steadfast love endures forever; // There are three

heavens: (1) the daytime sky, (2) the nighttime sky, and (3) the dwelling place of God!

- 6. ⁶ to him who spread out the earth above the waters, for his steadfast love endures forever; // After days 1 and 2 of creation, the earth was still completely covered by water; then, on day 3, "God said, 'Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear.' And it was so" (Gen. 1:9 ESV).
- 7. ⁷ to him who made the great lights, for his steadfast love endures forever; // On day 1 "God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light" (Gen. 1:1 ESV). Then, on day 4, He created the sun, the moon, and the stars!
- 8. ⁸ the sun to rule over the day, for his steadfast love endures forever; // The LORD is infinitely intelligent, so He set an ideal distance of 93 million miles between our sun and the earth; a little further away would make the earth too cold, a little closer would make it too hot!
- 9. ⁹ the moon and stars to rule over the night, for his steadfast love endures forever; // Years ago I sometimes found myself driving all night; when the sky was clear and the moon was nearly full, it was as if the LORD had turned on a night light just for me! Not sure if God awesome? Drive away from the city lights at night, then gaze at the stars and you will say "YES"!

Wonders of the Exodus: Exodus 11-12

- 10. ¹⁰ to him who struck down the firstborn of Egypt, for his steadfast love endures forever; // That was the tenth plague; the LORD passed over every house marked with the blood of a lamb, but *in every other house* at least one person was dead. The Passover pointed ahead to Jesus' work to save us from our sins!
- 11. ¹¹ and brought Israel out from among them, for his steadfast love endures forever; // So with the tenth plague, Pharaoh said to Moses and Aaron, "...go out from

among my people, both you and the people of Israel; and go, serve the LORD..." (Ex. 12:31 ESV).

- 12. ¹² with a strong hand and an outstretched arm, for his steadfast love endures forever; // The LORD made it clear to Pharaoh that *the LORD is God*!
- 13. ¹³ to him who divided the Red Sea in two, for his steadfast love endures forever; // The LORD led the Israelites to the Red Sea, and they appeared to be trapped, *but then the LORD divided the sea!*
- 14. ¹⁴ and made Israel pass through the midst of it, for his steadfast love endures forever; // With Pharaoh's army rapidly approaching to slaughter them, they were compelled to pass through between the two walls of water!
- 15. ¹⁵ but overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red Sea, for his steadfast love endures forever; // So the Israelites were saved, while the Egyptians were killed!
- 16. ¹⁶ to him who led his people through the wilderness, for his steadfast love endures forever; // It was awesome; *He led with a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night!*

Wonders of the Conquest: Numbers 21:21-35

- 17. ¹⁷ to him who struck down great kings, for his steadfast love endures forever; // Some kings seemed to be great, but the LORD is far greater!
- 18. ¹⁸ and killed mighty kings, for his steadfast love endures forever; // Some kings seemed to be mighty, but the LORD showed His might and protected His people by killing those mighty kings!
- 19. ¹⁹ Sihon, king of the Amorites, for his steadfast love endures forever; // The Israelites simply wanted to pass through the land of the Amorites, but Sihon said "no" and fought Israel, so the LORD defeated Sihon!

- 20. ²⁰ and Og, king of Bashan, for his steadfast love endures forever; // Even though Og had sixty cities, the LORD gave all of them to the Israelites!
- 21. ²¹ and gave their land as a heritage, for his steadfast love endures forever; // The Israelites received the land as an inheritance, because of their **relationship** with God! It is for that same reason that we will inherit God's kingdom!
- 22. ²² a heritage to Israel his servant, for his steadfast love endures forever. // Again, the topic is relationship; *let us be thankful for our relationship with God through Jesus!*

God's Loving Care:

- 23. ²³ It is he who remembered us in our low estate, for his steadfast love endures forever; // When they were slaves in Egypt, the LORD remembered them!
- 24. ²⁴ and rescued us from our foes, for his steadfast love endures forever; // So the LORD took powerful action on behalf of the Israelites *to set them free*!
- 25. ²⁵ he who gives food to all flesh, for his steadfast love endures forever. // David prayed to the LORD: "You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing" (Psalm 145:16 NIV). So, before every meal, *let us* acknowledge and thank the LORD!

Conclusion:

26. ²⁶ Give thanks to the God of heaven, for his steadfast love endures forever. // We all have countless blessings, so let us *think about them, *be thankful for them, and *share with those who are in need!

<u>Let us pray</u>: Father in heaven, you have given us bodies that live, eyes that see, ears that hear, and tongues that taste; You have also given Your own Son to bring us into Your holy family; therefore, *fill us with thanksgiving*!
