**OLD TESTAMENT:** Isaiah 57:1-2 NIV – The blessings of those who die in Jesus!

<sup>1</sup> The <u>righteous</u> perish, and no one ponders it in his heart; devout men are taken away, and no one understands that the righteous are <u>taken</u> <u>away</u> to be spared from evil.

<sup>2</sup> Those who <u>walk uprightly</u> enter into <u>peace</u>; they find <u>rest</u> as they lie in death.

- L: The Word of the Lord.
- C: Thanks be to God.

## Comments:

- "righteous" People who trust in Jesus as their Savior; they are *perfectly right* in God's sight.
- "taken away" Death has two perspectives:
  - Loved ones on earth sad, because death has brought separation.
  - God in heaven happy, because He has taken a believer in Jesus from this evil world to Himself in heaven!
- "walk uprightly" The fruit of faith in Jesus!
- "peace" The blessed state of those who have died with their faith in Jesus!
- "rest" The bodies of those who died in Jesus are resting, until He raises them to live forevermore (John 5:28-29).

# **PSALM 139:1-18, 23-24 NIV** – The Lord made us, knows us, and loves us!

- L: O LORD, you have searched me and you know me.
- C: You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar.
- L: You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.
- C: Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD.
- L: You hem me in--behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me.
- C: Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.
- L: Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?
- C: If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.
- L: If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea,
- C: even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.
- L: If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me,"
- C: even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you.
- L: For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.
- C: I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
- L: My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth,
- C: your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

- L: How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!
- C: Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you.
- L: Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.
- C: See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
- A: Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.



**EPISTLE: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 NIV** – *Those who die in Jesus will not be forgotten!* 

<sup>13</sup> Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who <u>fall asleep</u>, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have <u>no hope</u>.

- "fall asleep" physically die
- "no hope" think death is the end

<sup>14</sup> We believe that <u>Jesus died and rose</u> again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have <u>fallen asleep in him</u>.

- "Jesus died and rose" Do you believe?
- "fallen asleep in him" believers

<sup>15</sup> According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive *[when He returns]*, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not *precede [somehow be ahead of]* those who

have fallen asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven [in a way everyone will be aware of], with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and <u>the</u> [bodies of the] <u>dead in Christ</u> will rise first.

 "the dead in Christ will rise first" – They will be ahead of those believers who are still alive when Jesus returns.

<sup>17</sup> After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up *[raptured]* together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage each other with these words.

L: The Word of the Lord.

#### C: Thanks be to God.

- "we will be with the Lord forever" Think about a Jewish wedding feast and John 14:2-3...
- "encourage each other with these words" – The best is yet to come!

#### Comments:

- As the blood of the Passover lambs in Moses' time spared the firstborn from physical death, so the holy precious blood of Jesus – God's Son, the promised Savior, the Lamb of God – spares all believers from eternal punishment.
- We reap the benefits of Jesus' work: By GRACE through FAITH in JESUS for ETERNAL LIFE!
