## The Book of Life

Sunday, 11/18 – 8:00 & 10:45 + Monday, 11/19 – 7 PM 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost / 25<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity – 2018

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today, as we recall that Bethlehem Lutheran Church was founded 114 years ago, we focus on the first part of Daniel chapter 12.

Dr. Luther made this comment: "The twelfth chapter of Daniel... has to do wholly with the Antichrist and with these last times in which we are living" (AE 35:313) (1423). Today's brief section is only three verses, <u>yet it describes</u> a time of great trouble before Jesus returns, the final judgment, and how we should proceed between now and then!

- Great Trouble: <sup>1</sup> "At that time [the end of the world] shall arise Michael [which means "who is like God" and is most likely the very Son of God], the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time [see the People's Bible Commentary, page 218, third paragraph].
  - a. *time of trouble*. Lesser times of trouble have come –
    when Antiochus Epiphanes (167 B.C.) sacrificed a pig on the altar at the Jerusalem temple and when Jerusalem fell to the Romans (A.D. 70); *both of those events point ahead to the GREAT TROUBLE before Jesus returns!*
  - b. *since there was a nation till that time*. So when did <u>nations</u> come into existence? Let's go to Genesis:
    - I. Ch. 1 The six-day creation account.

- Ch. 2 Creation details; the first wedding; and life before the fall.
- III. Ch. 3 The fall; promise of the Savior; first blood sacrifice; and clothes.
- IV. Ch. 4 Cain murders Abel; a list of Cain's descendants; and cities.
- V. Ch. 5 The descendants of Adam to Noah (how we date the flood).
- VI. Ch. 6 Intermarriage between believers and nonbelievers; the increase of wickedness; the promise of the flood; and the building of the ark.
- VII. Ch. 7 The worldwide flood.
- VIII. Ch. 8 The water subsides; Noah offers sacrifices.
  - IX. Ch. 9 God promises to never flood the whole world again, then He set His bow in the cloud as a sign of His promise; Noah's three sons.
  - X. Ch. 10 The descendants of Noah's sons; and the first four appearances of the word <u>nations</u>.

**Summary:** The greatest trouble ever was the worldwide flood. The greatest trouble since the nations will be shortly before Jesus returns!

2. Final Judgment: But at that time your people [those believing in the Messiah, the Christ] shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book." // The ones in the book are the ones whom God has \$chosen before creation, \$washed in the blood of the Lamb, and \$kept, through His Word, in the one true faith! These are some Bible references to "the book of life":

- a. Revelation 3:5 ESV [Jesus to the believers in Sardis:] The one who conquers [who, by God's grace, continues to believe in Me to the end]... I will never blot his name out of the book of life [Matt. 10:22].
- b. Revelation 13:8 ESV ...and all who dwell on earth will worship [the beast from the sea], everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life... // The beast they worship represents the anti-God ways of secular governments, for example: no prayer in schools, abortion, evolution, and same sex marriage. Even though nations oppose God in various ways, many people strongly agree <sup>(C)</sup>?
- c. Revelation 17:8 ESV ...the dwellers on earth whose names have <u>not</u> been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world will marvel to see the beast, because it <u>was</u> and <u>is not</u> and <u>is to come</u>. // In Revelation chapter 13, the first beast received a fatal wound, yet he was healed; then all the **un**believers were amazed and followed him. For us, *let us always* have faith in and follow our Lord Jesus Christ!
- d. Revelation 20:12 ESV And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life.
  - "books" Some books record all deeds, another book records the names of those whom God has chosen before creation to be His own (Eph. 1:3-8a).
  - II. "the dead were judged... according to their deeds"
     ALL will be judged evaluated by their deeds; those knowing Jesus will be found innocent; those rejecting Jesus will be found guilty!

- e. **Revelation 20:15 ESV** ...if anyone's name was <u>not</u> found written in **the book of life**, he was thrown into the lake of fire. // So each one who rejects Jesus!
- f. Revelation 21:27 ESV ...nothing <u>unclean</u> will ever enter [the New Jerusalem], nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life. Only in Jesus are we clean!
- g. <sup>2</sup> "And many [thus all] of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake [John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15b-16], some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt [PBC, 219-220].
- 3. Between Now and Then: And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever [PBC, 220-221]." // Since we know that we are so blessed through Jesus, let us make Him known to others!
  - a. <u>Who is the Church</u>? All who by grace through faith believe in Jesus for eternal life!
  - b. What is the task of the Church?
    - To be salt and light, in our decaying and dark world – so let us reflect the light of Christ, by sharing God's Truth about sin and salvation!
    - II. As Bethlehem <u>has</u> proclaimed God's Word of life to enliven the dead and build up those who are in Christ, <u>may the same continue until Jesus returns</u>!

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, TY for choosing us to be Your own and blessing this congregation for 114 years! As trouble increases around us, *please keep us, help us, and use us*!
