"Forgiveness is a Gift!" So the FIRST STEP is taken BY THE

PERSON WHO HAS THE GIFT!

Based on Various Passages – NIV 2nd Wednesday of Lent – 2010 February 24 → 11:00 & 7:00

Introduction: Dear friends, we have all sinned against God and others, so we are all in need of the gift of forgiveness – both from God and from others!

But first, what is a gift? A gift is "something to show friendship, affection, support, etc." (Random House, 569) A gift is given from the HEART OF THE GIVER in connection with a NEED OF THE RECEIVER! For example:

- A person is hungry *that is his need*, so a person with food SUPPORTS the person who is hungry by giving him food as a GIFT *not because he earned it, but because he needed it!*
- A person has sinned against you so he is in need of your forgiveness. He doesn't deserve it but he needs it, so you show him FRIENDSHIP by giving him the GIFT of forgiveness!

In this sermon we will focus on **God's gift of forgiveness to us** AND **our gift of forgiveness to others**!

1. **God's Gift of Forgiveness to Us:** God's gift to us is a PACKAGE of blessings! Some of the *most important*

contents of that package include + the full forgiveness of our sins, + spiritual life, and + eternal salvation!

- a. Those eternal blessings come to us by GRACE:
 - i. G God's
 - ii. **R** Riches
 - iii. 🗛 at
 - iv. **C** Christ's
 - v. **E** Expense

Even though we CANNOT earn them and can do NOTHING to deserve them, we have received them by grace through faith! GRACE is God offering them – because Christ has fully paid for them! While faith is also God's gift to us – which enables us to receive His eternal gifts! As the Bible says: "It is because of him [God the Father] that [we] are in Christ Jesus..." (1 Cor. 1:30 NIV)

- <u>These passages will help us understand the grace</u> the undeserved love and goodness – <u>of God's gift</u>:
 - i. NAS Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death [since we have all sinned, we all deserve *physical death* and *eternal punishment*], but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." We deserve the worst, but God is offering us the most wonderful GIFT in Christ Jesus our Lord!
 - ii. ^{NIV} Ephesians 2:1 "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins…³ …Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath [*that is all bad news* and we cannot escape].⁴ But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, ⁵ made us

alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by grace you have been saved." In other words, *it is by GOD taking two wonderful actions* (by the Spirit through Baptism and through the Bible):

- 1. GOD offers us the free gift of full forgiveness in Christ!
- 2. And GOD enables us by faith to receive His wonderful gift!

2. Our Gift of Forgiveness to Others:

- <u>Should we wait to offer the GIFT of forgiveness until</u> <u>people are sorry</u>? Our sinful nature says: "Yes!" But God says: "No!"
 - i. What did God do for us? "...while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Rom. 5:8 NAS) He didn't wait until we were sorry!
 - In fact, offering the gift of forgiveness can lead a person to be sorry: "...God's kindness leads you toward repentance..." (Rom. 2:4 NIV)
 - We should act FIRST! Jesus said: "And when you stand praying, if you hold ANYTHING against ANYONE, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." (Mark 11:25 NIV) There is a definite connection between our forgiveness to others and God's forgiveness to us!
- b. <u>Our entire motivation for GIVING THE GIFT OF</u> <u>FORGIVENESS is based upon OUR RECEIVING OF</u> <u>GOD'S GIFT OF FORGIVENESS</u>!

- i. We wronged God, so He gave us the GIFT of forgiveness through Jesus!
- ii. Now, as others wrong us, God calls us to give them the GIFT of forgiveness!
- c. <u>But the sinful world says</u>: "Get revenge!" Even our own sinful natures draw us in the same direction: "It is right to give him the same in return!" Though we are tempted in such ways – and sometimes we fall, we are now DIFFERENT in Jesus Christ!
- d. <u>God is calling and empowering us to **be** and **live** who we are in Christ:</u>
 - i. Be → ^{NAS} 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man is in Christ, *he is* a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come." We remain in this sinful world, but we no longer belong to this sinful world; *we are NEW* and DIFFERENT in Christ!
 - ii. Live → ^{NAS} 2 Corinthians 5:15 [Jesus] died for all, that they who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf." So how do we live for Christ? The Bible says: Forgive "each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." (NIV Ephesians 4:32)

Conclusion: Now, *rejoicing in God's gift of full forgiveness in Jesus Christ*, let us go forth to offer that same gift of full forgiveness to ANYONE and EVERYONE who has ever sinned against us! And all God's people said: *Amen*!

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
