Let Us Gladly Receive Him...

THE CHRIST OF CHRISTMAS!

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: I'm so glad we are HERE, on the very day we celebrate our Savior's birth, to hear God's Word, hsing God's praises, and hreceive the assurance that, in the Christ of Christmas, our sins are forgiven!

However, <u>regarding Christmas in America</u>, <u>what are the</u> <u>trends</u>? Here are four from a Pew Research poll:¹

- How many Americans are celebrating Christmas? About 90%, but less than half celebrate Christmas as a religious holiday... and the numbers keep going down, especially among Millennials (those 22-37 years old).
- 2) <u>Merry Christmas or Happy Holidays</u>? *More and more are becoming comfortable with saying Happy Holidays*.
- 3) <u>Religious displays on government property</u>? *More and more say that such displays should NOT be allowed*.
- What about the ♦virgin birth, ♦angelic announcement to shepherds, ♦manger-bed, and ♦wise men? About half believe such things, with the numbers declining.

Dear friends, even though many are trending away from ✦God's Word of Truth and ✦the Christ of Christmas, let us

rejoice in + our God-given faith, + the forgiveness of our sins, and + the blessed eternity that is coming through Jesus! Now, we turn our attention to today's gospel reading, which is packed with many wonderful realities about \checkmark the Son of God, \checkmark His coming into the world, and \checkmark our eternal blessings!

- 1. The Son of God: We are in John chapter 1:
 - a. <u>Before creation</u>: ¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through him, and without him not any thing was made that was made. // <u>Who is the Word who was with God in</u> the beginning? The Word is *the Son of God!* He was "begotten of His Father before all worlds" (Nicene Creed). Also, the Father worked *through the Son* to make all things!
 - b. Life and light: What about those topics?
 - i. ⁴ In him [the Son] was life, and the life was the light of men.
 - <u>Regarding life</u>: Imagine a house with only ONE electrical outlet; you must plugin there to get power. Now, think of Jesus being the ONE source of life – both physically and spiritually; physically—because, apart from Him, we do not exist, and spiritually—because, apart from Him, we are spiritually dead (Eph. 2).
 - <u>Regarding light</u>: That is referring to God's truth, which shows us *◆our* sin and *◆God's rescue through Jesus!*

- ii. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. // We live in a dark world of sin and death, yet the Son of God is shining the truth AND the darkness CANNOT overpower it! So we are on the WINNING team!
- 2. John the Baptizer Prepared the Way: ⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him. ⁸ He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light. // John the Baptizer was the forerunner of the Christ, so He prepared the way by *calling people to repent* and *pointing them to Jesus!* How CAN WE do something similar in our lives toward others?

3. The Son of God in Human Flesh:

- a. <u>Rejected by many</u>: ⁹ The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.
 ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.
 ¹¹ He came to his own [to the Jews], and his own people did not receive him.
 - <u>Thinking about Jesus</u>: Everyone has sinned, so everyone needs Jesus! However, many people are unaware of their need. <u>Why</u>? Because they refuse to get into the Bible in a serious manner. Everyone SHOULD receive Jesus, and yet sadly, many reject Him.
 - ii. <u>A modern-day example</u>: Steve Jobs founded the company we know as Apple;

then, some years later, *he was basically fired!* Wow, he was the CEO, *but the board fired him*. Oh, and Jesus, <u>as the Son</u> <u>of God</u> He created the world and, <u>as the</u> <u>God-Man</u> He would redeem the world, yet *His own people basically fired Him!*

- b. <u>Received by some</u>: ¹² But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, ¹³ who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. // Note the word "gave"; without God giving, and giving freely, no one could be a member of His family. God had to make the way through His Son; then, God had to enable us to take that way by grace through faith! Now, we are born of God!
- 4. Conclusion: ¹⁴ And the Word [the Son] became flesh and dwelt among us [for a while, to remove our sins], and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. // That is Christmas THE WORD BECAME FLESH! Wow, we are so blessed because with the eyes of our God-given faith we have seen and trust in the Christ of Christmas!

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, *TYSM for taking away our sins!* Now, *as we celebrate Your birth with others*, help us to reflect Your light and speak God's truth in love!
