Enslavement & Freedom

At the Highest Levels!

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: We used to be a nation whose laws agreed with the Bible, but now we are standing against the Almighty God ()! How?

- By electing godless and corrupt politicians who have no fear of God and no concern for the people they serve.
- By making the *Bible, *creation, *Jesus, and *prayer illegal in our public schools.
- By legalizing *abortion, *homosexuality, and *suicide.
- By no longer supporting the many good police, through whom <u>God</u> commends the good and punishes the evil.

Since *•our freedoms are being taken away and •our future is uncertain,* let us *•repent* and *•draw close to God*! Because: "Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD" (Ps. 33:12 ESV).

The freedom of our nation is important, but *even more important* is the freedom of our eternal souls. Regardless of <u>color</u> or <u>culture</u> or <u>language</u>, **all who reject Jesus** *are enslaved at the highest level*, while **all who trust in Jesus** *are free at the highest level*! We now focus on 6 of the 10 Bible verses which include the word "**freedom**."

1. Sin Enslaves, Christ Frees: This passage identifies CREATION losing its freedom: ^{ESV} Romans 8:20-21 "...the creation was subjected to [brought under] futility [frustration] [by God]... in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God." // When the people fell, God pulled down I creation itself and I future people. We are all fallen people living in a fallen world; however, let us always look forward to Jesus' return when all believers and creation itself will be fully restored!

2. The Holy Spirit and Freedom: ^{ESV} 2 Corinthians 3:15-17

"...to this day whenever Moses [that is, when one of the first five books of the Bible] is read a veil lies over their hearts [that is, the hearts of all who reject the Lord]. But when one turns to the Lord [by the work of the Spirit through the Word], the veil is removed. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is **freedom**." // Those who reject Jesus are enslaved by sin, so sin is their master; for those who have been set free by the Spirit, they are \$free from condemnation, \$alive to Jesus, and \$have the Spirit living within them!

3. The Forces of Evil are Trying to Re-Enslave Us:

^{ESV} Galatians 2:1-2, 4-5 "I [Paul] went up [to Jerusalem]... and set before them... the gospel... Yet... false brothers... slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in Christ Jesus [freedom from sin's condemnation and control], so that they might bring us into slavery..." // Dear friend: For all of us who are in Christ, ♥we live in a sin-filled world, ♥the forces of evil are among us, and ♥the old nature is inside of us! <u>And what are they all trying to do</u>? They are at work – *in a way that we barely notice* – to ^(C) tear us away from Jesus, ^(C) re-enslave us to sin, and ^(C) drag us to hell! <u>Have they succeeded</u>? "Test yourselves *to see* if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you-- unless indeed you fail the test?" (2 Cor. 13:5 NAS).

4. Christ Plus = Enslavement; Christ Alone = Freedom:

ESV Galatians 5:1-3 For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision [as a requirement of your salvation], Christ will be of no advantage to you. I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. // As the believers in Galatia were being tempted to receive circumcision as a part of their salvation, so many today are being tempted to add something to Christ like – being good, being to church, being money, betc. All such things are certainly important, BUT THEY DO NOT ADD TO OUR SALVATION, *WE ONLY NEED JESUS CHRIST!* In fact, if we try to add to Christ, then we won't have Christ!

- 5. We are Free in Christ, but Not Free to Sin: ^{ESV} Galatians 5:13 "...you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh..." // When we were apart from Christ, we were free to sin... with the result of eternal punishment. However, now, being ♥in Christ, ♥free from God's condemnation, and ♥heaven-bound, we are free at the highest level! Now, each day, by the guidance and power of the Holy Spirit, let us drown the old and follow the new!
- 6. Beware of False Prophets and False Teachers: False prophets say, "The LORD said..." when He has NOT! False teachers purposely change the meaning of the Bible for their own personal gain. Regarding such people, the Bible says in ^{ESV} 2 Peter 2:19: "They promise them freedom [for example, believe what I say, follow me, and your life will be amazing], but they themselves are slaves of corruption [living in sin now and headed for eternal destruction]. For whatever overcomes a person, to that he is enslaved." // So with all we believe about God, let us believe ONLY what agrees with the Bible!

Conclusion: This year, as we celebrate our nation's 244th birthday, let us **)**<u>praise</u> our Great God, **)**<u>be thankful</u> for the freedoms we enjoy, **)**<u>keep praying</u> for our nation, and **)**<u>support</u> whatever agrees with the Bible! Then, as we enjoy our national freedoms, let us **)**be diligent to NOT be enslaved to sin and **)**make our freedom in Christ our highest treasure!
