The Day of Pentecost – 2021 <u>Saturday</u>, 5/22 at 4:00 & <u>Sunday</u>, 5/23 at 9:00



Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today is the Day of Pentecost; here is some <u>history</u> and <u>meaning</u>:

- The 7 annual OT festivals see Leviticus chapter 23; festival 3 – Firstfruits; festival 4 – Pentecost.
- Pentecost in Greek means 50; Firstfruits to Pentecost was 50 days; Jesus was raised on the day of Firstfruits.
- OT: Pentecost looked back to God's giving of the Law.
 NT: Pentecost celebrates the sending of the HS.

In this sermon, Jesus and His disciples are in the upper room and He is teaching them about the Spirit's <u>coming</u> and <u>work</u>.

 He Testifies about Jesus: Jesus said to His disciples:
 ²⁶ "When the Helper [that is, the Holy Spirit] comes, whom I will send to you from the Father [from the F, to the S, to the disciples], that is the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me, ²⁷ and you will testify

also, because you have been with Me from the beginning...

- a. <u>How did the Spirit testify about Jesus to His disciples</u>? Jesus said to His disciples: "...the Holy Spirit... will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you" (John 14:26 NAU).
- b. <u>How did Jesus' disciples testify to others</u>? By the work and power of the Spirit they \$told the truth, \$called people to repent, and \$wrote the NT Scriptures.
- 2. He Helps Believers: Earlier in chapter 16, Jesus told His disciples that *they would be put out of the synagogues and *people would think they were serving God by killing them. Then Jesus said: ^{16:4b} These things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you. ⁵ "But now I am going to [the Father] who sent Me; and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' ⁶ "But because I have said these things to you [regarding *the troubles that will come upon you and *Me leaving you], sorrow has filled your heart. ⁷ "But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.
 - a. The Holy Trinity and salvation:
 - i. The Father made the plan and sent His Son.
 - ii. The **Son** took away the sin of the world.
 - iii. The Holy Spirit was sent to make the Son known and move people to repent (S-H-H-S-J).
 - b. <u>Sorrow and joy</u>: Within 18 hours or so of Jesus saying those words He was dead – **sorrow**, but God raised Him up on the third day – **joy**!

c. <u>Help</u>: 40 days after Jesus was raised, *He left, thus He ascended into heaven*. Since ***Jesus was gone and ***trouble was coming for the disciples, *they were richly blessed with the coming of the HS 50 days after Easter*.

3. He Convicts the World:

- a. ⁸ "And [the Holy Spirit], when He comes, will convict the [unbelievers in the] world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment... // How does the HS do <u>His work</u>? Back then and today:
 - i. Christians share God's Truth with others.
 - ii. Then the HS works through that truth to show unbelievers that they are guilty.
- b. These are the three topics of guilt...
 - i. ⁹ <u>concerning sin</u>, because they do not believe in Me... // ♦Everyone is terminally ill with sin and
 ♦Jesus is the only cure; when those realities are made known, ♦some will repent⁽²⁾ and ♦some will further harden their hearts to God's saving truth⁽²⁾.
 - ii. ¹⁰ concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me... // Many try unsuccessfully to make themselves righteous by ☺lowering God's requirement or ☺denying their sins or ☺blaming others for their sins. <u>But only</u> through Jesus – who ascended to the Father – can a person be righteous!
 - iii. ¹¹ concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged. // Even though people deny the coming judgment, they should realize \$Satan has been judged already and \$they will also be judged – unless they repent.

- 4. He Tells the Truth: ¹² "I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. ¹³ "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. ¹⁴ "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose *it* to you. ¹⁵ "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose *it* to you. // <u>The Spirit enables us to</u>...
 - a. <u>Understand the Bible</u>: As we hear, read, and study the Bible *the HS enables us to understand the Bible*!
 - b. <u>Live the Bible</u>: Once we understand the Bible *the HS enables us to live the Bible!*
 - c. <u>Share the Bible</u>: Once we realize the great benefits of the Bible (*forgiveness, *peace, *guidance) the HS encourages us to share the Bible with others!

Conclusion<mark>:</mark>

- <u>Truth</u> Believers have the Spirit (1 Corinthians 3:16).
- <u>Relevance</u> Believers understand, live, and share the Bible.
- Inspiration Believer's share; then the Spirit convicts.
