

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today is part 5 of the series: <u>The Child of Promise and Fulfillment</u>.

- Part 1: The reality of God adopting us into His family!
- <u>Parts 2 & 3</u>: God's messenger, John the Baptizer, is promised; then, 400 years later, John is born!
- Part 4: Our Savior, the Sun of Righteousness, is promised!
- <u>Part 5</u>: Today, Zacharias tells what God the Father will do through John and Jesus to gift *forgiveness and *peace to all who are repentant!

The Text (Luke 1:76-79): On the day that John was named, Zacharias, *moved by the Holy Spirit*, said these words: ⁷⁶ "And you, child, will be called a prophet of the Most High. For you will go ahead of the Lord to prepare His ways—⁷⁷ to make known to His people that they can be saved by the forgiveness of their sins, ⁷⁸ because our God is merciful and will let a heavenly Sun rise upon us—⁷⁹ to shine on those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace."

- John The Last and Greatest Prophet: ⁷⁶ "And you, child, will be called a prophet of the Most High. For you will go ahead of the Lord to prepare His ways
 - a. <u>The Most High</u>: He planned to save us through His Son; then, *at the right time*, God sent John to prepare the way for Jesus, *who is the Lord*.
 - b. <u>OT NT</u>: **An OT summary**: God promised to send His Son; **a NT summary**: God did send His Son.
 - c. John's rank: God spoke through many prophets to prophecy about Jesus, but John was the last and the greatest! John actually *saw Jesus and *prepared His way. Also, Jesus said, "...there is no one greater than John" (Lk. 7:28).
 - d. John's preparation: Imagine being a water salesman; what would make your job easy? It would be easy if everyone was thirsty! Some of you may be familiar with Marcus Luttrell, the Navy Seal known as the lone survivor. In 2005 in Afghanistan, after *multiple gunfights, *multiple falls down a mountain, *multiple gunshot wounds, and *a broken back, he said: Finding water "was the only thing I could think about.... All I cared about was the thirst."¹ How did John

prepare the way for Jesus? By helping people SEE THEIR GREAT NEED, calling them TO REPENT, and pointing them TO JESUS!

- Good News Everyone Can Be Saved: Zacharias, regarding John's task: ⁷⁷ to make known to His people that they can be saved by the forgiveness of their sins,
 - a. <u>Why saving is needed</u>: It's because of sin, which *kills spiritually* and *condemns eternally*. When people think *sin is no big deal*; then they will think *Jesus is no big deal*. Imagine warming yourself at a roaring campfire *nice!* Imagine being in the roaring campfire *terrifying!* For all who die without Jesus, the Bible uses words like eternal punishment, everlasting destruction, biblazing furnace, weeping and gnashing of teeth, and eternal place fiery lake of burning sulfur.
 - b. Forgiveness is being freely offered: Even though
 all have fallen short of God's will and are deserving of a horrible eternity; all can be saved through God's gift of forgiveness!
- Salvation Based on God's Mercy: Zacharias, about how people can be saved: ⁷⁸ because our God is merciful and will let a heavenly Sun rise upon us—
 - a. <u>God's heart of mercy</u>: Heart is "the deep, inner seat of tender emotions" (Friberg, BW). Mercy is "an attitude and emotion roused by the affliction of another" (Friberg, BW).
 - b. <u>A heavenly Sun</u>: As we put heart and mercy together, God, *in the depth of His being*, is greatly concerned about all people. Therefore,

He sent "the Sun of Righteousness [the heavenly Sun, the dayspring, the morning star] with healing in His wings" (Mal. 4:2 AAT) – **not** because we are good, **but** because He is good!

- Light For Those Who Know the Darkness: Zacharias, regarding the purpose of God's Son: ⁷⁹ to shine on those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace."
 - a. <u>Those in artificial light</u>: They are the ones who think ♦their sins are no big deal and ♦they will be welcomed into heaven on their own goodness.
 - b. <u>Those sitting in darkness</u>: They "are utterly helpless, tired, worn out, giving up the struggle, hopeless" (Lenski, 112). They are also in the shadow of death, *meaning death and hell are very near*. Though many unbelievers deny it, *they know death is coming and they are afraid*!
 - c. <u>John's mission</u>: To guide our feet into the way of peace; ⊃not some feeling of calmness, security, or rest, ⊃but an actual relationship with God!

Conclusion<mark>:</mark>

- <u>Truth</u> Unrepentant sinners will be eternally condemned!
- <u>Relevance</u> Believers have God's forgiveness thru Jesus!
- Inspiration Peace is true friendship with God thru Jesus!
