

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Even though we just celebrated Jesus' birth, we know He was born to die – to save us from our sins! Today, nearly 8 billion people are living in the world; some are like Simeon – VERY BLESSED because they are ready to die. Let's learn what that means as we focus on ♦the exodus and ♦baby Jesus being brought to the temple.

## 1. Don't Forget: Exodus 13:1-3a, 11-13

a. <u>Remember</u>: <sup>1</sup> ...<u>the LORD spoke to Moses</u>, saying, <sup>2</sup> "<u>Sanctify</u> [set apart] to Me every firstborn... among the sons of Israel, both of man and beast; it belongs to Me [because I rescued it from the tenth plague]." <sup>3</sup> <u>Moses</u> <u>said to the people</u>, "Remember this day in which you went out from Egypt...; for by a powerful hand the LORD brought you out from this place...." // God permitted that time of slavery; then, *especially through*  the tenth plague, which included the blood of unblemished male lambs (⇒Jesus), He set them free!

b. <u>Redeem</u>: <sup>11</sup> "Now when the LORD brings you to the land of the Canaanite... and gives it to you, <sup>12</sup> you shall <u>devote [sacrifice]</u> to the LORD the first offspring of every womb, and the first offspring of every beast that you own; the males belong to the LORD. <sup>13</sup> "But... every firstborn of man among your sons you shall redeem."
// Most firstborn male animals were sacrificed (Deut. 15:21), but the sons were redeemed – to remember God's past rescue and look ahead to His future rescue!

## 2. An Exciting Day at the Temple<mark>: Luke 2:22-40</mark>

- a. <u>Purification and Redemption</u>: <sup>22</sup> ...when the days for <u>their purification</u> [that is, Joseph and Mary] according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought <u>Him</u> [Jesus] up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord <sup>23</sup> (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "EVERY firstborn MALE THAT OPENS THE WOMB SHALL BE CALLED HOLY TO THE LORD" [and needs to be redeemed]), <sup>24</sup> and to offer a sacrifice [for the purification] according to what was said in the Law of the Lord, "A PAIR OF TURTLEDOVES OR TWO YOUNG PIGEONS."
  - i. <u>Purification</u>: A woman who had a male child had to wait 40 days; then she and her husband would bring a sacrifice to the temple – normally a one-year-old lamb and a turtledove or a young pigeon. <u>The poor</u> man's sacrifice was two turtledoves or two young pigeons (Lev. 12:6-8). Since Joseph and Mary did not bring a lamb, that indicates that they had not yet received the gift of gold from the wisemen.

- ii. <u>Redemption</u>: The price to redeem Jesus, the firstborn son, was "five shekels [or two ounces] in silver" (Num. 18:16). Today's value: About \$40.
- b. <u>Simeon</u>: <sup>25</sup> And there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; and this man was righteous and devout, looking for the <u>consolation</u> [comfort] of Israel; and the Holy Spirit was upon him. <sup>26</sup> And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. // Simeon, an OT believer who trusted in the coming Messiah would see the Messiah before he died!
- c. Now dismiss: <sup>27</sup> And he [Simeon] came in the Spirit [being *led by the Spirit*] into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to carry out for Him the custom of the Law (to pay the redemption price), <sup>28</sup> then he took Him into his arms, and blessed God, and said, <sup>29</sup> "Now Lord, You are releasing Your bond-servant to depart in peace, According to Your word; <sup>30</sup> For my eyes have seen Your salvation, <sup>31</sup> Which You have prepared in the presence of all peoples, <sup>32</sup> A LIGHT OF **REVELATION TO THE GENTILES, And the glory of Your people Israel.**" // Those are the words of the Nunc Dimittis, which are Latin for Now Dismiss. Peace is being in relationship with God through Jesus! Simeon •believed in, •saw, and •held his Savior; he was ready to depart, thus, to die in peace! When we know Jesus through our God-given faith, we are also ready to die!
- d. <u>Fall and rise</u>: <sup>33</sup> And His father and mother were amazed at the things which were being said about Him. <sup>34</sup> And Simeon blessed them and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this *Child* is appointed for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and for a sign to be <u>opposed</u>

[spoken against] -- <sup>35</sup> and a sword will pierce even your own soul-- to the end that thoughts from many hearts may be revealed." // For each person, <u>everything for</u> <u>eternity depends on Jesus</u>; those who **reject** Him fall to hell, while those who **embrace** Him rise to heaven!

- e. <u>Anna</u>: <sup>36</sup> And there was a prophetess, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years and had lived with *her* husband seven years after her marriage, <sup>37</sup> and then as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the temple, serving night and day with fastings and prayers. <sup>38</sup> At that very moment she came up and *began* giving thanks to God, and continued to speak of <u>Him [Jesus]</u> to all those who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem. // Another assurance that Jesus is the One!
- f. Jesus: <sup>39</sup> When they had performed everything according to the Law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own city of Nazareth. <sup>40</sup> The Child continued to grow and become strong, increasing in wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him. // From Matthew, we know that the lives of Joseph, Mary, and Jesus followed <u>this series of events</u>: From Jerusalem, *they returned to Bethlehem and were visited by the wisemen*; then, having been warned in a dream about Herod's soldiers, *they fled to Egypt*; then, after Herod died, *they returned to Nazareth!*

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, keep us sorry for our sins and trusting in Jesus for eternal life; then, knowing we are ready to depart in peace, *help us to live unto Your glory*!
