10. <u>After the Lord's Prayer</u>: After teaching the Lord's Prayer, Jesus said: "...if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But **if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions**" (Matt. 6:14-15).

A Forgiveness Difference:

11. God's forgiveness to us is *HIS forgiveness*, but our forgiveness to others is *OUR forgiveness*. We forgive because God has forgiven us, but the other person still needs God's forgiveness!

Summary

God's forgiveness to us:

- Planned it before we sinned.
- Offers it to us as a gift.
- Offers it when we are not sorry.
- Offers it when we do not deserve it.
- It's free, full, and immediate.

God's forgiveness to others:

- He offers it to everyone.
- Only those who receive it have it.

Our forgiveness to others:

- We planned it before they sinned.
- We offer it to others as a gift.
- We offer it when they are not sorry.
- We offer it when they do not deserve it.
- Our forgiveness is free, full, and immediate.

Conclusion

Look at the image on the front: As a confined wild bird rejoices to be free, so we should rejoice in God's forgiveness!

Now, having been set free by God, *let* us set others free and point them to God by offering our forgiveness – freely, fully, and immediately!

Finally, *let us pray for all who sin against us* (Matt. 5:44), which will *bless them* and *give us peace!*

Introduction

Forgiveness – Who Is Involved?

God, Us, and Others:

- God He is eternal, all-powerful, all-knowing, holy, gracious, and merciful.
- Us From the viewpoint of this brochure, we are repentant sinners. What does that mean? By the work of the Holy Spirit:
 - We know we have sinned against God (Ps. 51:4).
 - We know we deserve hell (Matt. 5:22).
 - We know we are helpless to escape (Rom. 5:6).
 - We are sorry for our sins (Acts 2:36-37).
 - We are trusting in Jesus for eternal life (Acts 16:31).
- Others From the viewpoint of this brochure, others are unrepentant sinners.



GOD'S FORGIVENESS TO US

God's Timing to Forgive Us:

- <u>God planned to forgive us before</u> <u>we sinned</u>: "[Christ] was foreknown before the foundation of the world" (1 Pet. 1:20).
- <u>God removed all sins on Good</u>
 <u>Friday</u>: "...I will remove the iniquity of that land in **one day**" (Zech. 3:9).

God's Justification to Forgive Us:

- Jesus fulfilled the law: "I did not come to abolish but to fulfill" (Matt. 5:17).
- Jesus bore all sins: "...the LORD [the Father] has caused the iniquity [sin, wickedness] of us all to fall on Him [the Son]" (Isa. 53:6).

God Gifting His Forgiveness:

 <u>God knows we cannot earn His</u> forgiveness, so He offers it to us as <u>a gift</u>: "...the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom. 6:23).

The Thoroughness of God's Forgiveness:

 <u>God fully forgives</u>: "If we confess our sins, [God] is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 Jn. 1:9).

GOD'S FORGIVENESS TO OTHERS

<u>Remember</u>: For this brochure, others are unrepentant sinners.

God Offering Forgiveness:

 <u>To everyone</u>: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (Jn. 3:16).

People Receiving Forgiveness:

 Only those who are trusting in Jesus for eternal life: "He who has the Son has the life..." (1 Jn. 5:12).

// Sadly, those who keep living in unrepentance also keep rejecting God's gift of forgiveness.

OUR FORGIVENESS TO OTHERS

Connections between God, Us, and Others:

9. During the Lord's Prayer:

"...forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors" (Matt. 6:12). // When we sin, we owe a debt to God. In the Lord's Prayer, we ask God to forgive the debts we owe to Him IN THE SAME WAY WE FORGIVE THE DEBTS THAT OTHERS OWE TO US.
