

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: This sermon is Part 3 of The Christian Engine. So far, we have:

- Compared the *four-stroke internal combustion engine* with the *five-stroke Christian engine*.
- Focused on the first stroke of the CE, which is the Bible.
 We learned *what it is, *why it should be important, and *how we should make use of it.
- Focused on the second stroke of the CE, which is prayer. We learned *what prayer is, *key factors to have in place when we pray, *why we should pray, *the significance of prayer for Jesus, and *the amazing power of prayer.
- Talked about three vital steps to <u>BENEFIT</u>: ⇒tell me,
 ⇒teach me, and ⇒involve me; all three are essential!

If you missed the last two Wednesday sermons, please watch, listen, or read to benefit!

- 1. Secret Worship Survey Results: Only 33 of 87 responded.
 - a. What is the main reason why you attend worship? The options: *to give or *to get. 19 marked both; 12 marked to get; and 2 marked to give.
 - i. <u>Let's think about the term "worship"</u>: It means to "bow down" – something we do to show great respect, and to "adore" – because of what God is: eternal, unchangeable, almighty, all-knowing, holy, just, faithful, good, merciful, and gracious.¹
 - ii. <u>Get versus give</u>: Both are important but GET is MORE IMPORTANT! **God** WILL be okay if we do not give, but **we** WILL NOT be okay if we do not get the gifts God is offering to us when we attend worship. See below for some details.
 - b. What do you give when you attend worship? The choices were *respect, *thanks, *prayer, and *money.

 Most marked all four; some marked only thanks and/or prayer. All four are Biblical and best:
 - i. Respect See above.
 - ii. <u>Thanks</u> Every good thing we have is ultimately from God, our Father (see James 1:17).
 - iii. <u>Prayer</u> See last week's sermon on prayer.
 - iv. Money "A tithe of everything... belongs to the LORD" (Lev. 27:30 NIV). We →acknowledge, →thank, and →honor God when we give 10% and keep 90%.
 - c. What do you get when you attend worship? The choices were *truth, *forgiveness, *peace, and *guidance. Almost everyone marked all four; some marked only 1 or 2 or 3 of the 4. All four are important:

- i. <u>Truth</u> Sets us free from our sins, which were eternally condemning us (John 8:31-32).
- ii. Forgiveness When we are clothed in Jesus' righteousness (Gal. 3:27), then we have God's forgiveness! But since we keep falling into sin, we keep needing assurance that we are forgiven.

 During our services, we are being assured through the *absolution, *invocation, *hymns, *Scripture readings, *sermon, *creed, and *Lord's Supper!
- iii. Peace There are various aspects, for example:
 - Peace between us and God through Jesus: Due to original sin, we were all opposed to God. But God has bought us back (redeemed us) through Jesus (Titus 3:5—Baptism; James 1:18—Bible)!
 - 2. Peace about our health: It is good to try to be healthy through our *eating, *exercising, and – as we get older – *regular checkups. But, for the health issues that are out of our control, we know God is in control – so we are at peace!
 - 3. Peace about world events: *War, *covid, *communism, *supply chain issues, *economic downturns, *etc. We hear about such things and should pray, but we are also at peace because the Almighty God is in control!
- iv. <u>Guidance</u> In today's world, we are receiving guidance from many sources: ₱some is good, ₱some is deceptive appearing good, but bad, and ₱some is openly evil. The BEST guidance is from God's word, so let us learn it and apply it!
- d. How can we make Bethlehem more desirable for visitors? 17 responded, these are some examples:

- ♦ Worshipers should identify new people and personally welcome them; ♦ Engage visitors more after the service, ask why they came; ♦ Each member invite friends; ♦ Less liturgy; ♦ Name tags; ♦ TY cards for visiting; ♦ Use the hymnal for DS; and ♦ Stay online.
- e. How can we make our church better? 18 responded, these are some examples: \$Use the service from the hymnal; \$Encourage a fast to put our focus on others; \$Keep it warmer; \$Less Law, more Gospel—uplifting; \$More fellowship time; \$More singing; \$Encourage participation; \$Get involved in the community—shovel a sidewalk, mow a lawn; and \$Have small group studies for men/women. Note: Thanks for responding; I heard you and will try to make things better for everyone.
- 2. The Christian Engine: Are you growing in understanding the function of the CE? When we believe in the heart; then we witness to others in word and deed! Then, in connection with those receiving our witness:
 - a. We dig into the Bible to find answers!
 - b. We pray for their understanding and repentance!
 - c. We invite to worship to get & give many things!
 - d. We invite to fellowship to get & give encouragement! As they *know* and *grow* in Christ, *they should keep moving through the same five strokes of The Christian Engine*.

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, since You are SO GREAT and we need what You are freely offering SO MUCH, move us to faithfully attend and invite others!
