



Text: Luke 24:1-12; 1Corinthians 15:19-26 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Are you a 2 + 2 = 4 kind of a person? If yes, then you base what you believe on  $\frac{1}{2}$  logic – it's reasonable, and  $\frac{1}{2}$  proof – it's factual.

Did Jesus die on a cross? Logic and proof say, "Yes!"

- Logic: When a Roman Centurion was entrusted with the job of putting a condemned criminal to death, he certainly followed through!
- Proof: John records that a soldier "pierced [Jesus'] side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out" (19:34). What does that mean? A retired cardiothoracic surgeon, Dr. Antony de Bono, wrote that "Jesus had a haemothorax," in other words, "in the stillness of [His] dead body, [the fluid separated] into two layers: the heavier red cells below and the light watery plasma above." The blood and water that came out of Jesus proved that He was dead!

Since most of us ▶are logical and ▶believe what is proven by experts, we are tempted to conclude that †Jesus died and †MUST STILL BE DEAD! However, based on →God's unshakeable truth and →the powerful work of His Spirit, ⊃our logic has been canceled and ⊃we are tightly embracing Jesus – our risen Lord and Savior !

In this sermon, we will \$\int \touch on the account of Jesus' resurrection according to Luke and \$\int \text{recall}\$ the essential importance of always remaining "In Christ."

## 1. The Resurrection of Jesus: Luke 24:1-12

- a. His Body Is Gone: <sup>1</sup> But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. <sup>2</sup> And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, <sup>3</sup> but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. // Those women had no thought of Jesus being raised; instead, they were filled with sadness and came to continue the process of anointing His dead body.
- b. Angels Announce: He Is Risen: 4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men [two angels (John 20:12)] suddenly stood near them in dazzling clothing; 5 and as the women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living One among the dead? 6 He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, 7 saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again."
  - i. Reaction to the Angels: \*Terrified! \*Faces to the ground! Angels are awesome beings created by a

- MUCH MORE AWESOME GOD, who is worthy of our total ⇒respect, ⇒trust, and ⇒obedience!
- ii. A Life-Changing Reminder: Remember what Jesus said: I will be †betrayed, †mistreated, and †crucified, BUT ON THE THIRD DAY I WILL RISE AGAIN! Upon hearing and remembering, and by the grace of God, they believed!
- c. Reporting; Disbelieving; Marveling: 8 And they remembered [Jesus'] words, 9 and returned from the tomb and reported all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. <sup>10</sup> Now they were Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the *mother* of James; also the other women with them were telling these things to the apostles. 11 But these words appeared to [the apostles] as nonsense, and they would not believe them. 12 But Peter got up and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen wrappings only; and he went away to his home, marveling at what had happened. // Twelve minus Judas – the eleven; they heard the report of the women, but leaning on their logic and proof, they would not believe . But Peter was curious, excited; he did not yet believe but he wanted to know more, so he RAN to the tomb, ₱remembered what Jesus had said, and ₱was in awe! Peter searched and God opened his way to the TRUTH, which cancels logic. Let us do the same!
- 2. Being "In Christ" Is Essential: 1 Corinthians 15:19-26
  - a. <u>Jesus, the Christ Is Risen</u>: <sup>19</sup> If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied. <sup>20</sup> But now <u>Christ has been raised from the dead</u>, the first fruits of those who are asleep. <sup>21</sup> For since by <u>a</u>

- man [Adam] came death, by a man [Jesus] also came the resurrection of the dead. // God's truth cancels logic!
- b. When Jesus Returns: <sup>22</sup> For as in Adam all die [because of sin], so also no Christ ell shall be made alive [all who are sorry for their sins, trusting in Jesus for eternal life, and honoring Him in their lives]. <sup>23</sup> But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming, <sup>24</sup> then comes the end, when He delivers up the kingdom to the God and Father, when He has abolished all rule and all authority and power. <sup>25</sup> For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. <sup>26</sup> The last enemy that will be abolished is death. // Death is a powerful enemy; we are helpless against death, but Jesus has defeated death! Now, we believe by faith; when He comes, our eyes will see!

## Take Aways:

- Truth Jesus was dead; now He is alive!
- Relevance His death removed all sin; through faith we have God's gift of eternal life!
- Inspiration Let us invite everyone to ▶stop trusting in themselves, ▶be sorry for their sins, ▶trust in Jesus for heaven, and ▶gladly honor Him in their lives!

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, TYSM for opening the way to heaven!

◆Keep us grasping You, ◆open blind eyes to the saving truth, and ◆lead all who are not currently "in Christ" to repent!
