

Introduction: Dear Friends in Christ: Our current sermon series is working through our eight I AM banners.


<u>So far</u>, we have focused on these words of Jesus, which are written on our banners on the **south** side of our worship area:

- 1. "I AM the Bread of Life" (John 6)
- 2. "I AM the Light of the World" (John 8)
- 3. "I AM the Door" (John 10)
- 4. "I AM the Good Shepherd" (John 10)

<u>Today</u>, we focus on banners 5 and 6, *which are located on the* **north** side of our worship area; Jesus said:

- 5. "I AM the Resurrection and the Life" (John 11)
- 6. "I AM the Way and the Truth and the Life" (John 14)

5. I AM the Resurrection and the Life (John 11:17-27). John chapter 11 focuses on three siblings: Lazarus, Mary, and Martha, who were friends of Jesus. When Lazarus became seriously ill, Mary and Martha sent word of his illness to Jesus.



a. <sup>17</sup> ...when Jesus came, He found that [Lazarus] had already been in the tomb

four days. <sup>18</sup> Now Bethany was near Jerusalem, about two miles off; <sup>19</sup> and many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary, to console them concerning *their* brother. <sup>20</sup> Martha therefore, when she heard that Jesus was coming, went to meet Him, but Mary stayed at the house. // "The days of deep mourning lasted for seven days" (Kretzmann), *so Jesus arrived during that time*. When a loved one is ill, *we pray for healing*. But when a loved one dies, it is normal and natural to be sad because of the separation that has occurred.


- b. <sup>21</sup> Martha then said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. <sup>22</sup> Even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You."
  <sup>23</sup> Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."
  <sup>24</sup> Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." // Martha expressed great faith in Jesus: "You could have healed Lazarus, "You will raise him on the last day, and, even now, "You could raise Lazarus from the dead!"
- c. <sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, "<u>I am the resurrection and the life</u>; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, <sup>26</sup> and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" <sup>27</sup> She said to Him, "Yes, Lord; I

have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world." // Let's break down what Jesus said:

- i. "<u>I am the resurrection and the life</u>" Jesus is our source of *physical life* and *eternal life*!
- ii. "...<u>he who believes in Me will live even if he dies</u>"
   For believers in Jesus: \*they are physically alive,
  \*most will physically die, and, when Jesus returns,
  \*He will make them physically alive again.
- iii. "...<u>everyone who lives and believes in me will</u> <u>never die</u>" – If, while physically alive, we believe in Jesus; then, even when we physically die, we continue living spiritually, thus, we never die! By the HS Martha believed such things. <u>Do you</u>?

## 6. I AM the Way and the Truth and the Life (John 14:1-6).

Now we are in John chapter 14 and Jesus is in the upper room with His disciples: \*The feet have been washed, \*the Passover meal is being eaten, \*Jesus has predicted His betrayal, \*Judas has left the room, \*Jesus has predicted Peter's denial, and \*Jesus has mentioned His departure. Then, knowing all things, Jesus said:



a. <sup>1</sup> "Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me." // As those disciples were troubled by the previous words and actions, so we find ourselves troubled at times. What is the cure? Trust in God the Father and in Jesus: They
\* are almighty, \* are in control, \* have a plan, and \* love us so very much!

- b. <sup>2</sup> "In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup> If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also." // Jesus' disciples had grown so close to Him and dependent upon Him. Since His departure troubled them, Jesus explained the reason for His departure and their future reunion: \*I am going to heaven, \*I will prepare a place for you.
- c. <sup>4</sup> "And you know the way where I am going." <sup>5</sup> Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, how do we know the way?" <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, "<u>I am the way, and the truth, and the life</u>; no one comes to the Father but through Me." //
  - i. <u>Where was Jesus going</u>? *To His Father's house*.
  - ii. <u>Where is God the Father</u>? *In heaven*.
  - iii. <u>How do we know</u>? Because Jesus taught us to pray: *Our Father who art in heaven*.
  - iv. <u>Why is Jesus the only way to heaven</u>? To enter, we must be righteous, that is, *sinless in God's sight*.
     For all who are righteous, *they are clothed in the righteous, perfect, sinless life of Jesus*. We receive Jesus' righteousness by grace through faith!

Let Us Pray: Dear Lord Jesus, each week, as we see our banners, let us I rejoice in knowing You, the Great I AM, I give thanks for the fullness of the life to come, and I continue trusting in You – the only way to the Father and to heaven!
