

Introduction: Dear friends: JESUS is the key! If you reject Him, heaven is locked for you. But if, by God's grace, you know Him, heaven is open for you. What are YOU doing with JESUS?

Who is **JESUS**? God's Son – *promised to Adam and Eve, *clothed in flesh through the Virgin Mary, *announced by angels, and *visited by shepherds and wisemen!

Then, when the time was just right, **JESUS** was *anointed by God the Father, *accompanied by the Holy Spirit, and *tempted by the devil, **yet** He never sinned!

Then, returning to Nazareth where He grew up, JESUS read the Scriptures and identified Himself as the Promised Messiah. <u>What did those people do with JESUS</u>? They tried to murder Him[®]. Knowing that JESUS is YOUR key for YOUR fabulous eternity, what are YOU doing with JESUS?

Matthew 4:12 follows JESUS' rejection in Nazareth.

- The OT Connection: ¹² Now when Jesus heard that John <u>[the Baptizer] had been taken into custody</u>, He withdrew into Galilee; ¹³ and leaving Nazareth, He came and <u>settled</u> <u>in Capernaum</u>, which is by the sea [of Galilee], in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali. ¹⁴ This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet [in Isaiah 9:1-4]: ¹⁵ "THE LAND OF ZEBULUN AND THE LAND OF NAPHTALI, BY THE WAY OF THE SEA, BEYOND THE JORDAN, GALILEE OF THE GENTILES-- ¹⁶ "THE PEOPLE WHO WERE SITTING IN DARKNESS SAW A GREAT LIGHT, AND THOSE WHO WERE SITTING IN THE LAND AND SHADOW OF DEATH, UPON THEM A LIGHT DAWNED."
 - a. <u>John Arrested</u>: John fulfilled His purpose preparing the way for **JESUS**; *then the spotlight turned to JESUS!*
 - b. Settled in Capernaum:
 - i. JESUS fulfilled prophecy by settling there.
 - ii. For all who are in the darkness of sin, JESUS, the True Light of the world, is the answer!
 - iii. Since Capernaum was on the shore of the sea of Galilee, *JESUS* could easily reach many people on foot or by boat – location, location, location...
- 2. The Reason to Repent: ¹⁷ From that time [after settling in Capernaum] Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." // If this life is all there



is – then there is NO NEED to repent. **But that is NOT true!** This life is only a drop in the bucket in comparison to the eternity that is coming for EVERYONE!

- a. <u>Eternity has two locations</u>: One is **super-wonderful** gladly received as God's gift; the other one is **superhorrible** – acquired after persistent rejection of JESUS.
- b. <u>Why Repent</u>? Repentance is the only way to enter God's *super-wonderful* eternity.
- c. What is Repentance?
 - Admitting we are helpless to save ourselves,
 mourning over our sin-causing separation (Mt. 5:4), and trusting in Jesus for eternal life.
 - When such things are true, we will ⊃hunger for God's word, ⊃believe God's word, and ⊃seek to live-out God's word in our daily lives.

3. Gathering Disciples:

- a. <u>Peter and Andrew</u>: From John 1:35-42, we know that Peter and Andrew had previously become acquainted with JESUS: ¹⁸ Now as Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, He saw two brothers, Simon who was called <u>Peter</u>, and <u>Andrew</u> his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ And He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."
 ²⁰ <u>Immediately they left their nets and followed Him</u>. // Immediately... followed – <u>Why</u>? The H.S. had enabled Peter and Andrew to believe in Jesus as the Messiah. So, +understanding Jesus' call, +they immediately left and followed! God has good works to do for EVERY believer. <u>How are YOU responding to His</u> <u>call</u>? *Stubbornly ignoring* or *Sfaithfully following*.
- b. James and John: From Luke 5:1-11, we know that prior to Jesus' call, Peter, Andrew, James, and John had

experienced a miraculous catch of fish. Now the Bible says: ²¹ Going on from [calling Peter and Andrew] He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and He called them. ²² Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him. // Again, the H.S. was certainly at work! The H.S. *is like a holy fire*; we should NEVER try to PUT OUT that fire *but respond with willing obedience*.

- 4. Teaching, Proclaiming, Healing: ²³ Jesus was going throughout all Galilee [with His disciples], teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel [good news] of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people. // What did Jesus teach? God's truth! What is the good news? All who repent and believe will be saved! What did Jesus heal? Everything! Then what happened?
- 5. Much Healing: ²⁴ The news about Him spread throughout <u>all Syria</u>; and they brought to Him <u>all who were ill</u>, those suffering with various diseases and pains, demoniacs, epileptics, paralytics; and He healed them. // All of them!
- Large Crowds: ²⁵ Large crowds followed Him from <u>Galilee</u> and the <u>Decapolis</u> and <u>Jerusalem</u> and <u>Judea</u> and from <u>beyond the Jordan</u> [Perea]. // Multitudes heard and followed! <u>What are YOU doing with JESUS</u>?
