

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Last week we began Peter's first letter – *discovering that he wrote to Jewish Christians* who had been scattered and were living in Asia Minor – *the area we know today as Turkey*.

Peter wrote about our **amazing eternal inheritance** – *the inheritance that is ours through our Spirit-given trust in Jesus!* He also told us that trials may be permitted into our lives. <u>Why</u>? **To prove our trust in Jesus to be genuine** – *which is very important to know with absolute certainty!* 

**Today**, as we continue in **1 Peter chapter 1**, Peter will tell us the HUGE reasons why **we believers** should **\***respect God and **\***sincerely love other believers. Then, knowing such things, *let us <u>greatly respect</u> and <u>greatly love</u>!* 

- 1. Why Believers Should Respect God:
  - a. <u>The precious blood of Christ</u>: <sup>17</sup> If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to

each one's work [in other words, if your trust is in Jesus for eternal life and God is your Father, then], conduct yourselves in fear [with respect, reverence, and awe] during the time of your [temporary] stay on earth; [Why?] <sup>18</sup> knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, <sup>19</sup> but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ. // The precious blood of Christ – <u>have you</u> thought about it?

- i. <u>Coverings for Adam and Eve</u>: Genesis 3 animal blood was shed to provide skin coverings.
- ii. <u>The first Passover</u>: Exodus 11-12 lamb blood was shed to spare the firstborn men from death.
- iii. <u>The Passover Meals from Moses to Jesus</u>: A period of about 1400 years and killing possibly 200,000+ lambs per annual celebration. So, <u>how many lambs shed their blood during those years</u>? *Maybe 280 million+!* Every *drop of blood* of every *lamb* was pointing ahead to Jesus, *The Lamb of God*, who was sent by the Father, *to take away the sin of the world including yours and mine!*
- iv. <u>The precious blood of Christ</u>: The very Son of God in human flesh ⇒ <u>†</u>living in our place, <u>†</u>shedding His blood, and <u>†</u>suffering our eternal penalty to → free us from *sin* and *death* and → provide the gifts of *forgiveness* and *eternal life*!
- b. <u>The monumental plan of God</u>: <sup>20</sup> For [Christ] was foreknown <u>before the foundation of the world</u> [that is, before the Son of God created the world], but has appeared Page 2 of 4

in these last times for the sake of you <sup>21</sup> who through [Christ] are believers in God [the Father], who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God [the Father].

- i. <u>Even before creation</u>, God knew about the fall into sin and planned to send the Christ.
- ii. <u>At the right time</u>, the Son of God put on human flesh for our eternal benefit.
- iii. <u>Now, by the work of the HS</u>, we believe in Jesus and in God the Father who raised Jesus.
- iv. Significant believing differences:
  - Some say, "I believe in God," but what does that mean – that some generic God exists?
  - We have been blessed to understand that \*the LORD is our Father, \*our Lord is Jesus His Son, and \*the Spirit has made such things known, then He established and maintains our relationship with the Father and His Son.

Thinking about *⇒who God is* and *⇒what He has done*, let us give Him the highest *♥*respect, *♥*honor, *♥*trust, and *♥*obedience!

## 2. Why Believers Should Sincerely Love Each Other:

<u>An eternal connection</u>: *That is what believers have with each other*; all believers *\**are alive in Christ, *\**are members of the one body of Christ, and *\**are seeking to know and be obedient to God's word. With those things in mind, *this is what Peter wrote*: <sup>22</sup> Since you [believers] have in obedience to the truth purified

your souls for a <u>sincere love</u>  $[\varphi \iota \lambda \alpha \delta \epsilon \lambda \varphi i \alpha - that is, a genuine brotherly love] of the brethren, <u>fervently</u> [eagerly, earnestly] love one another from the heart [from deep within (not on the surface)], <sup>23</sup> for you have been born again not of seed which is <u>perishable</u> [like our earthly lives] but <u>imperishable</u> [eternal], ...through the living and enduring word of God. // Here we are, *believers in Jesus – saved, forgiven, *in possession of eternal life, and *united together in one holy family with all other believers. <u>What should we do</u>? We should <sup>(2)</sup> pay attention to our brothers and sisters in Christ, <sup>(2)</sup> see their needs, and <sup>(2)</sup> eagerly show them genuine love in word and deed!$ 

b. <u>The eternal word</u>: <sup>24</sup> For, "ALL FLESH IS LIKE GRASS, AND ALL ITS GLORY LIKE THE FLOWER OF GRASS. THE GRASS WITHERS, AND THE FLOWER FALLS OFF, <sup>25</sup> BUT THE WORD OF THE LORD ENDURES FOREVER." And this is the word which was preached to you. // Since
God's word is eternal and > the Holy Spirit has worked through it to give us eternal life and unite us to God's holy family, let us ✓ recognize what the Spirit has done for us and ✓ gladly continue in that forever word of God ⇒ ⊃reading it, ⊃studying it, ⊃living it, and ⊃sharing it!

Let Us Pray: Dear F, S, and HS! Your goodness to us is OVER THE TOP! TYSM! Now, in response, help us to *highly* respect You and *sincerely* love our brothers and sisters in Christ!
