

The Ascension of Our Lord – 2023

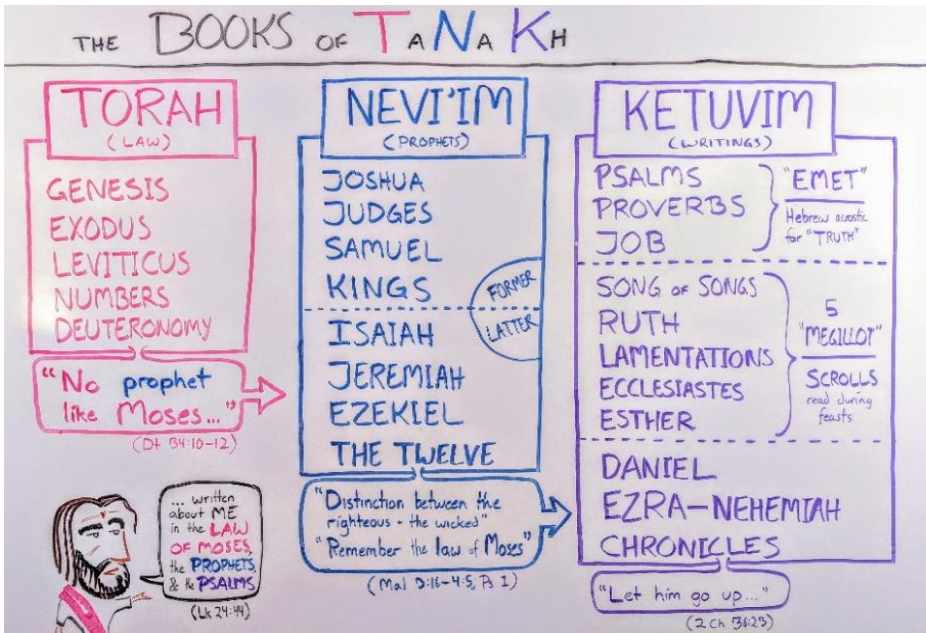
Text: Luke 24:44-51 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: The Lord Jesus Christ is now ☞risen from the dead and ☞reigning over all things for our temporal and eternal benefit!

In this sermon we will learn about ♣Bible basics, ♣Jesus' final words, ♣Jesus' ascension, and ♣our mission as Christians.

- Bible Basics:** The Bible is God's word of saving truth:
 - The Old Testament explains ♣our origin, ♣the fall into sin, and ♣God's promise to save us.
 - The New Testament shows us ♣who Jesus is, ♣what He did, and ♣why He is the one way to heaven.
- Jesus' Final Words:** ⁴⁴ ... [Jesus] said to [His followers], "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."

- a. During Jesus' time on earth: The NT had not yet been written, so *the Scriptures* were the **OT Scriptures**! The OT pointed ahead to the work Jesus would do to take away the sin of the world!
- b. Law, Prophets, Psalms: That is *one way* of dividing the OT into three parts. The **HEBREW OT** has the same information as **OUR OT**, but some of the books *have different names* and *are laid out in a different order*. The order of the **Law, Prophets, and Psalms** fits the order of the **Hebrew OT**. Study this diagram:¹



- c. A great blessing:⁴⁵ **Then** [the Bible records that] **[Jesus] opened [the] minds [of His followers] to understand the Scriptures...** // Jesus could have said:
- I am the promised descendant of Eve, *the Messiah*.
 - When the time was right, *I put on human flesh, then I lived a sinless life as your perfect substitute*.

- iii. While I was nailed to a cross, *I received all sins and God's wrath, then I laid down my life.*
 - iv. On the third day, *my Father raised me back to life.*
 - v. Now, on this 40th day, *I will be carried into heaven.*
 - vi. Before I go, *let me tell you about your mission.*
- d. Repentance unto forgiveness: ⁴⁶ **and [Jesus] said to them, “Thus it [has been] written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷ and that repentance [unto] forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.”** // God planned, and then Jesus accomplished the plan to provide forgiveness for all people. Now, all people are being invited to:
- i. Repent: To ♦acknowledge their sins, ♦understand what their sins deserve, ♦see their helplessness to save themselves, and ♦be sorry for their sins.
 - ii. Believe: To trust in Jesus alone as their Savior from ♦sin, ♦death, and ♦eternal punishment.
- e. You know what you saw: ⁴⁸ **“You are witnesses of these things.”** // Jesus’ apostles ♦heard His teachings and ♦saw His miracles. They saw Him dead and alive again! We haven’t seen, *but by the HS we believe!*
- f. I will give you power: ⁴⁹ **“And behold, I [send] the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from high.”** // Ten days after Jesus ascended was ♦50 days after Easter and ♦the fourth spring festival of Pentecost.² On that day *Jesus poured out the HS upon His followers!*

3. **Jesus' Ascension:** ⁵⁰ And [Jesus] led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. ⁵¹ While He was blessing them, He parted from them and was carried up into heaven. // Jesus is no longer visible on earth, but now He is in heaven and ruling over all things. At the appointed time (Acts 17:31), He will return like a thief in the night (1Th 5:2).
4. **Our Mission as Christians:**
- a. Since the HS has enabled us to ▶ understand God's word, ▶ be sorry for our sins, and ▶ embrace Jesus as Savior and Lord, we also have the HS living in us to **guide us** and **power us**.
 - b. Since we are alive in Christ, we have a concern about those who do not yet know Him. Therefore, let us:
 - i. Be open to the HS equipping us by ▶ studying, ▶ memorizing, and ▶ living the Bible.
 - ii. Pray for opportunities to point others to Jesus.
 - iii. Seize the opportunities that arise.

Let Us Pray: Dear Lord Jesus, *TYSM for saving us and ruling over all things for the good of all believers.* With gladness and awe, make us open and obedient to your will for our lives!
