Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: <u>What is a PROPER</u> <u>Thanksgiving</u>? *GIVING THANKS to the Almighty God!*

 Martin Luther in 1529: When beginning to explain: "Give us this day our daily bread," he wrote: "God certainly gives daily bread to everyone without our prayers, even to all evil people, but we pray in this petition that God would lead us to <u>realize</u> this and to <u>receive</u> our daily bread with thanksgiving." // Think about the 8.1 billion people in the world, or the **334 million** people in the United States – *each one is living and eating*. <u>How is that possible</u>? Because the LORD keeps opening His hand and satisfying the desire of every living thing (Ps. 145:16). *Let us realize it and give Him thanks!*

2. George Washington in 1789: See part of his Thanksgiving Proclamation in the image above.... Thanksgiving is not about eating turkey or watching football – things that we might want to do, but Thanksgiving Day was intended to be a day to publicly and prayerfully acknowledge the countless and undeserved blessings that the Almighty God has showered upon us. Let us do such things and encourage others to do the same!

3. Today's Readings Encourage Proper Thanksgiving:

a. Deuteronomy 8:1-10:

- i. ² "You shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you..." // The LORD did that for the Israelites then and for our nation today – from sea to shining sea. Let us realize it and give Him thanks!
- ii. ⁴ "Your clothing did not wear out..." // The LORD did that for the descendants of Israel during their 40 years in the wilderness. For us, we have an abundance of all we need. Let us realize it and give Him thanks!

- iii. ⁷ "...the LORD your God is bringing you into a good land..." // That was the Promised Land, flowing with milk and honey. The land of the USA is also a very good land. Let us realize it and give Him thanks!
- iv. ¹⁰ "When you have eaten and are satisfied, you shall bless the LORD your God for the good land which He has given you." // We have eaten and been satisfied countless times! Even though we are tempted to forget the LORD, Let us keep realizing what He is doing, then, let us keep giving Him thanks!
- b. Psalm 67: "Let the peoples praise you, O God... Let the nations be glad and sing for joy..." // As one of the most blessed nations in the world, it is right and proper that we would be among the most thankful nations in the world. Let us do our part to be thankful today and every day!
- c. 1 Timothy 2:1-4: "I urge that <u>entreaties</u> [requests] and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men..." // We, as believers in Jesus, have an open line to the Almighty God; therefore, let us talk with Him on behalf of others – by making requests and giving thanks!

d. Luke 17:11-19: ¹⁵ "Now one of [the ten men who was cleansed of his leprosy], when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice..." // What did <u>he do</u>? He realized that he had received a miraculous healing through Jesus; therefore, *he thanked and praised and glorified God!* Our illness was not leprosy, *but the incurable disease of sin*, which leads to death and hell. BUT we have been healed by grace through faith in Jesus! Therefore, let us realize what we have received – *eternal life*, and let us give thanks to the Almighty God!

Let Us Pray: LORD God Almighty, Your power is awesome, and Your love is amazing! Moment-bymoment, day-by-day, help us and many others to realize what You keep providing, and then move us with heartfelt gladness to keep giving You thanks!
