

## Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Advent is a time to remember our sins and •be thankful for our Savior.

### In this sermon we will:

- Learn a sad reality about mankind's fall into sin.
- Better understand the LORD's promises to Abram.
- Identify a characteristic of those who know Jesus.

This is part 2 of a 9-part sermon series.

Develop a habit of reading, thinking, answering, and praying!

## Day 4 – Wednesday, 12/6 – Sin Passing from Adam to All

**Read and Think** (4000 BC): Genesis 5:3 When Adam had lived one hundred and thirty years, he became the father of *a son* in <u>his own</u> <u>likeness</u>, according to <u>his image</u>, and named him Seth.... // Psalm 51:5 [David said:] ...in sin my mother conceived me.... // Romans 5:12 ...just as through <u>one man</u> [that is, Adam] sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned...

### Answer and Pray:

- God created the first people in *His image and His likeness* (see the 12/6 sermon); however, after they fell into sin, they could only have children in **their** image and **their** likeness. <u>What does that mean</u>?
  - Before the fall, they \*had dominion over God's living creatures, \*were holy, \*had sound reasoning, and \*exercised their free will unto God's glory.
  - After the fall, their \*dominion, \*holiness, \*reasoning, and \*use of freedom was corrupted.
- Why do we believe people inherited sin? Three reasons:
  - From the earlier passages Adam's fallen likeness and image passed to his children; David had sin from conception because he inherited it; and the inherited sin from Adam brought death to all people.
  - From children dying If children had no sin, they would not die, but David's first son from Bathsheba died when he was only 7-days old – due to his inherited sin!
  - From children having sin before they know right from wrong – The Bible says, "...if a person knows what is right, but does not do it, he is sinning" (Ja. 4:17 NET). Since a child doesn't know right from wrong until he is about 2-years-old, his sin must be inherited!
- What are the results of sin? Physical death "to dust you shall return" (Gen. 3:19), and Peternal punishment "the wages of sin is <u>death</u> [*i.e.*, eternal punishment]" (Rom. 6:23).
- How does the content in this section apply to you?
  Because of the fall, I have sin, so I need Jesus!

# OT Passages Pointing To the Coming Savior: 12/7 – 12/17

Day 5 – Thursday, 12/7 – Land, Relatives, Blessings

**Read and Think** (2000 BC): **Genesis 12:1-3** Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go forth from your country [*land*], And from your relatives [*descendants, seeds*] And from your father's house [*blessings*], To the land which I will show you; And I will make you a great nation, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing; And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

<u>The key words are *loaded* with meaning:</u>

- Land two meanings: The temporal land of Canaan and
  the eternal land of heaven: Hebrews 11:9-10 "By faith
  [Abraham] lived as an alien in the land of promise... looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God."
- Descendants three meanings: The blood relatives of <u>Abram</u>; the <u>Messiah Himself</u>, the Ultimate "Seed" of Abram (Gal. 3:16); and the <u>spiritual descendants of Abram</u>, all Jews and Gentiles with the faith of Abram (Rom. 9:6-8).
- Blessings Keil and Delitzsch identify these four blessings:
  - **1.** [Abram would] increase into a numerous people.
  - 2. [Abram would be given] material and spiritual prosperity.
  - 3. [the name of Abram would be elevated to a place of] honor and glory.
  - 4. [Abram would become] the possessor and dispenser of the blessing – i.e. the Messiah's flesh would be from Abram; the Messiah Himself would redeem all people!

Answer and Pray:

- When Abram was 75 years old, the LORD called him to leave *his* land, relatives, and blessings to receive *the LORD's* land, relatives, and blessings. Do you have the desire to know and follow the LORD's will for your life?
- In Genesis 12, about 2000 years after the fall, the LORD identified Abram as the family through whom the Messiah

would eventually come; then, going forward, the OT focused on Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and his descendants.

 How were all families blessed through Abram? The Messiah came through Abram to take away all sins! Through faith, we are spiritual descendants of Abram!

## Day 6 – Friday, 12/8 – Prophet Like Moses, Listen to Him

**Read and Think** (1400 BC): Deuteronomy 18:15 "The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall <u>listen to him</u>." ... **Matthew 17:5** While [Peter] was still speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed [Peter, James, and John], and behold, a voice out of the cloud said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; <u>listen to Him</u>!"

#### Answer and Pray:

- About 1400 BC, Moses told the Israelites that God would raise up a prophet like him; Jesus is that prophet!
- Both Moses and God the Father said, "listen to Him," what does that mean? Basically: obey! Details: \*be open, \*hear, \*believe, \*desire to understand, and \*make application!
- How does this day 6 content apply to you? Since the Bible says, "...prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves" (Jas. 1:22), may the Holy Spirit grant each of us the desire to be doers of what Jesus said from our repentant hearts!

Let Us Pray: Dear LORD, knowing that sin and death have passed to us and all, *we TYSM for Jesus*, the Ultimate Seed of Abraham who took away the sin of the world! Please help us to *\**fully trust in Jesus for eternal life and *\**gladly live for Jesus every day of our lives!
