## God's Amazing Grace and Mercy

**Text: NAS 1995** 

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: You have heard the words, *GRACE* and *MERCY*, but:

- What do grace and mercy mean?
- What is the grace and mercy coin?
- 1. The Words, "Grace" and "Mercy" What Do They Mean?
  - a. Grace (χάρις *pronounced*, charis):
    - i. <u>Appears</u>: χάρις in its various forms appears 155 times in the NAS-95 Bible.
    - ii. <u>Means</u>:
      - 1. <u>BW, Friberg</u>: "God's attitude toward human beings [translated:] *kindness, grace, favor.*"
      - 2. God's *undeserved* or *unmerited* love / favor.
      - 3. God loves us *because God is love*, NOT because we are good and deserve His love.
      - 4. <u>G</u>od's <u>R</u>iches <u>At</u> <u>C</u>hrist's <u>E</u>xpense:

- a. <u>God's Riches</u>: Forgiveness, spiritual life, and eternal salvation!
- b. <u>At Christ's Expense</u>: The Son of God
  came down from heaven, \*put on flesh,
  lived in our place, \*received our sins,
  received our eternal punishment, and
  laid down His life!
- iii. <u>Example</u>: "...by <u>grace</u> you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God" (Eph. 2:8). // In other words, because of God's <u>favor</u> toward us, and NOT because of any goodness on our part, God saved us through faith!
  - "by grace" The grace (kindness, favor) of God makes salvation by faith possible!
  - 2. "through faith" <u>Faith</u> is:
    - a. Given by the Holy Spirit!
    - b. In Jesus for eternal life!
    - c. <u>Sustained</u> by the Holy Spirit through God's word!
- iv. <u>Summary</u>: Since we cannot earn God's love or salvation – because we are poor sinners, we desperately need God to love us and save us. <u>Good News</u>: God does love us and has saved us!
- b. Mercy (ἕλεος pronounced, eleos):
  - i. <u>Appears</u>: ἕλεος in its various forms appears 27 times in the NAS-95 Bible.
  - ii. <u>Means</u>:

- 1. <u>BW, Friberg</u>: "gracious [kind, favorable] action demonstrating God's compassion [concern]."
- <u>Google</u>: "compassion or forgiveness shown toward someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm." Jesus said to His disciples, "...fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell" (Matt. 10:28). We are familiar with this passage, "the wages of sin is death..." (Rom. 6:23). Our sins earned eternal punishment. Therefore, we are so thankful for God's mercy!
- iii. <u>Example</u>: God "saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy..." (Tit. 3:5).
- iv. <u>Summary</u>: There is NOTHING in our thoughts, words, or deeds that moved God to save us. Instead, God showed us mercy by ♦<u>holding back</u> <u>the eternal punishment we DO deserve</u> and ♦<u>gifting us with the eternal salvation we DO NOT</u> <u>deserve</u>!
- 2. What Is the Grace and Mercy Coin? It looks like this:





- i. <u>Symbol</u>: A dove for the Holy Spirit, who works through baptism (Titus 3:5) and the Bible (1 Peter 1:23) to give us the benefits of Jesus' saving work!
- ii. <u>Words</u>: Grace is when God gives you what you don't deserve
- iii. <u>Verse</u>: 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 "Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by <u>grace</u>, comfort and strengthen your hearts in every good work and word."
- b. Mercy:
  - <u>Symbol</u>: A cross for Jesus' saving work, by which He bore *◆*our sins and *◆*our eternal punishment to be the Lamb of God and take away the sin of the world!
  - ii. <u>Words</u>: Mercy is when God spares you what you do deserve
  - iii. <u>Verse</u>: **1 Peter 1:3** "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great <u>mercy</u> has caused us to be born again [made spiritually alive] to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead..."
