"Faith is a living, busy, active, mighty thing!"

Rev. Dr. Martin Luther Text: James 2:14-18 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: <u>How is a person saved</u>?

- By faith alone OR
- By faith + works

I hope you answered, "<u>faith alone</u>"; however, in today's text, the Bible says: "Even so <u>faith</u>, if it has no works, is dead..."

Think about that... *faith without works is dead!* So, it sounds like "<u>faith alone</u>" *must be wrong!*

Please listen carefully:

- To understand about your own salvation!
- To learn how to explain this apparent contradiction.

1. A CLAIM of Faith, But the Person has No Works:

- a. <u>The Text</u>: ¹⁴ What use is it, my brethren, if someone says he has faith [that is, claims to have faith] but he has no [μή] works? Can that faith save him?
 - i. "<u>faith</u>":
 - <u>Note Carefully</u>: The text is talking about someone who SAYS he has faith, <u>but</u> does NOT have faith, he is merely CLAIMING to have faith!
 - <u>Multitudes of People</u>: They CLAIM to have faith and even believe they have faith, but many are deceived – and don't even know it.
 - <u>What is faith</u>? Here is an easy definition: Forsaking All I Trust Him.
 - a. <u>Forsaking All</u>: The HS enables us to put **no trust for heaven** *in anything we have done*.
 - <u>I Trust Him</u>: The HS enables us to put *all trust for heaven* in *Jesus*.
 - ii. <u>The Questions and Answers in the Text</u>:
 - <u>The Text Contains Two Questions</u>: "What use is it...?" and "Can that faith save him?"
 - <u>What are the Answers</u>? Both answers are "No." <u>How can we be</u> <u>certain</u>? Because both questions in the Greek include the negative

particle, $\mu \dot{\eta}$ (pronounced may), therefore, the answer to each question is **"No."**

- a. <u>What use is such faith</u>? It is of **NO use**, it is useless!
- b. <u>Can such faith save a person</u> <u>from his sins</u>? **NO!**
- b. <u>The Example</u>: ¹⁵ If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you <u>Says</u> to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and be filled," and yet you <u>do not give</u> them what is necessary for their body, what use is that? // Again, from the Greek text, we know the answer: <u>SAYING</u> without <u>GIVING</u> is of <u>NO use</u>!
- 2. When There Are No Works, *Faith Is Dead*: ¹⁷ Even so <u>faith</u> [that is, the claim of having faith], if it has no works, is dead, being by itself.
 - a. <u>Dead Faith Cannot Save</u>: Dead faith is when someone *falsely claims to have faith*.
 - b. Dead Faith Cannot Produce Works:
 - i. <u>Why</u>? Works that are acceptable to God *MUST COME FROM FAITH*!
 - ii. <u>Hebrews 11:6</u> "And without faith it is impossible to please [God]..."
- 3. Works Can Show Faith: ¹⁸ But someone may *well* say, "You have faith and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works."

- a. <u>What Are Works</u>? The Greek word is ἕργα (pronounced *erga*). Works are "a practical demonstration or proof of [faith] (BW, Friberg).
- b. "show me your faith without the works":
 - i. <u>Faith Is Invisible</u>: *Only God can see our faith!* A person can CLAIM to have faith, but without works, *his faith is dead!*
 - ii. <u>Think about a Person Lying Down</u>: Someone may say, "He is alive!" However, if he has **NO breathing** and **NO heartbeat**, thus **NO evidence of life**, then he is dead!
- c. "<u>I will show you my faith by my works</u>": *Let's be careful here!* Some are <u>true</u> and some are <u>false</u>:
 - i. <u>True Christian</u>: A person **with** *godly sorrow* and *trust in Jesus for eternal life*, who OPENLY demonstrates *love for God and neighbor*.
 - ii. <u>False Christian</u>: A person lacking godly sorrow and/or trust in Jesus, but who OPENLY does good things. <u>What did Jesus</u> <u>say about such people</u>? "I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead" (Rev. 3:1 NIV).

Let Us Pray: Dear HS, grant us *saving faith and *the evidence of God-honoring works! For all who are deceived, *show them the truth and *give them the gift of saving faith!
