



Introduction: Dear friends: A lot of people <u>confess Christ</u> (saying they are Christians), **but they don't <u>live Christ</u>. What's** going on with such people? Here are two options:

- They CLAIM to have faith, but they DON'T. (Or)
- They are very immature in their faith (like a growing seed that has not yet emerged from the dirt).

I hope you are IN CHRIST and IT SHOWS!

<u>If you are not in Christ</u>, *it is critical to repent!* Don't *force yourself* to do good things! Instead, be open to God working a <u>true change in you</u> **FROM THE INSIDE OUT!**

Going to James chapter 3, he wrote to people who confessed Christ but lived like the world! Some believed, some did not!

1. Do What You Know with Humility: ¹³ Who among you is wise [possessing knowledge] and understanding [skillful in using what you know]? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom. // What is James <u>saying</u>? Do you know something? Do you know how to use that something? Then do it with humility!

- Be Honest: ¹⁴ But if you have bitter jealousy [envy] and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and so lie against the truth. // When we have sin in our heart and deny it, we "lie against the truth." Instead, let us ★ confess our sins and ★ turn from our sins!
 - a. <u>Understand the Source</u>: ¹⁵ This wisdom is not that which comes down <u>from above</u> [from God], but is earthly, natural, demonic.
 - b. <u>Understand the Results</u>: ¹⁶ For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing. // LORD, please forgive us and change us!
- 3. Practice Godly Wisdom: ¹⁷ But the wisdom from above is first pure [w/o sin], then peaceable [promoting peace], gentle, reasonable [willing to work with others], full of mercy [compassion] and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy [genuine]. ¹⁸ And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. // God, through Jesus, has established peace between us and Himself[©]. Now, as the forgiven children of God, let us be peacemakers as we ♦speak and ♦live God's saving truth!
- 4. Avoid Sinful Pleasures: ^{4:1} What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your <u>pleasures</u> [desires] that wage war in your members? // When the old nature controls our lives, then we will have trouble in our lives. James gave these explanations:
 - a. ² You <u>lust</u> [have a sinful desire] and do not have; so you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain;

so you fight and quarrel. // Unrestrained sin on the inside leads to horrible sin on the outside!

- b. You do not have because you do not ask. // That's part of the problem not asking, but there is more.
- c. ³ You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong [sinful] motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures. // Luke Timothy Johnson made this pertinent comment: "The gift-giving God is here manipulated as a kind of vending machine precisely for purposes of self-gratification" (278).¹
- 5. Be Careful Who You Befriend: ⁴ You <u>adulteresses</u>, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore, whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. // <u>THINK</u>: God gave His Son to the horrible suffering and death on a cross for the purpose of making us His own.
 - a. <u>What Is a Proper Response to God</u>? **TOTAL DEVOTION TO GOD!** So, when we make friends with the sinful world, we are committing spiritual adultery!
 - b. James Continued: ⁵ Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: "He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us"? // Why? Because He wants the Spirit to lead us FROM God-<u>opposing</u> ways TO God-<u>honoring</u> ways!
- 6. Turn From Pride To Humility: ⁶ But He gives a greater grace [God extends grace to all; God extends even GREATER GRACE to His holy children]. Therefore *it* says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE." // <u>As</u>

greatly gifted believers, we **NEVER** want to oppose God, so let us always ♦be humble and ♦trust in God (see Luke 14:11)!

7. Go Forward in All these Ways:

- a. ⁷ Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. // Let us know God's word, AND THEN *let us do it*! THEN we can resist the devil!
- b. ⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.
 [HOW?] Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. // God is calling us to stop living a double life on one hand, confessing Christ, and, on the other hand, living like the fallen world! He is calling us to repent FROM THE INSIDE OUT! How to get started? Dive into God's word with an open mind and an open heart!
- ⁹ Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom. // Let us be filled with proper godly sorrow for all the ways we are dishonoring our Great God!
- d. ¹⁰ Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.
 - i. <u>Pride trusts in self</u>, *so let us trust in God!*
 - ii. Let us be humble no bragging, no taking credit, but giving all the glory to God!
 - iii. <u>Down the road</u>, when the time is right, **God will** exalt us!

Let Us Pray: Dear Holy Spirit, ⇒bring us to Christ, ⇒keep us in Christ, and ⇒give us proper works that glorify God!

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
