Aware of the End,

We Live By God's Word

Text: Jude 1:20-25 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: As we live in this moment in time, we are also aware that the world – as we know it – is eventually going to end. <u>Therefore</u>, this is our focus today:

AWARE OF THE END, WE LIVE BY GOD'S WORD

Some Basics:

- Jude is a half-brother of Jesus, who was moved by the Holy Spirit to write his letter.
- The book of Jude:
 - It's 1 of the 5 one-chapter books in the Bible (the others are Obadiah, Philemon, 2 John, and 3 John).
 - It's the second-to-last book in the Bible.
 - It warns us to beware of false teachers.
 - O It reminds us about ☺God's desire to save and
 ☺God's coming punishment upon the ungodly.
 - It describes the ungodly as *grumblers,
 *faultfinders, *lustful, *arrogant, *mockers,
 *dividers, *worldly-minded, and *devoid of the Spirit.

Now, coming to Jude, verse 20, he is calling us believers to be the <u>opposite</u> of the <u>ungodly</u>.

- What to Do as We Wait for Jesus: ²⁰ But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, ²¹ keep yourselves in the love of God, <u>waiting anxiously for</u> [anticipating, longing to receive] the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life. // What do those things mean?
 - a. <u>Build Up Our Faith</u>: **How?** By **learning** and **doing** the word of God *like eating and exercising, we take the word in, then we do what it says!*
 - b. Pray in the Spirit: How?
 - i. By praying *♦in* agreement with the word of God, in other words, by praying *♦back* the word of God!
 - ii. Jesus described His followers as *salt and light*, so we could pray like this: "Lord, as salt and light make a positive difference, so use me to make a positive difference in the lives of others!"
 - c. <u>Remain in God's Love</u>: **How?** By remaining *in harmony with the word of God while* – **at the same time** – *we are longing to receive Jesus' eternal compassion and kindness, that is, the FULNESS of eternal life!*
- 2. How to Care about Others: ²² And have mercy on some, who are doubting; ²³ save others, snatching them out of the fire; and on some have mercy with fear, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh. // What do those things mean?

- a. <u>Build Up Doubting Ones</u>: How? By *caring about them, *sharing God's truth with them, and
 *being patient with them.
- b. <u>Save Burning Ones</u>: How? By *loving them unconditionally, *warning them about the coming judgment, and *calling them to repent and believe. WE can <u>love</u>, <u>warn</u>, and <u>call</u>, **but** ONLY THE HOLY SPIRIT can save them!
- c. <u>Show Mercy with Fear</u>: How? Be aware of the spiritual tug-of-war between good and evil. As we try to pull others out of their sins, we must THOROUGHLY HATE THEIR SINS so that we are NOT pulled into their sins!
- 3. Focus on God: ²⁴ Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, ²⁵ to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, *be* glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
 - a. <u>God has Saved Us</u>: He worked in conjunction with the Holy Spirit to **†**clothe us in the righteousness of Christ, **†**wash us clean, and **†**bring us into His kingdom!
 - b. God Keeps Us in the Faith:
 - i. "[God] who began a good work in you will perfect it *[or bring it to completion]* until the day of Christ Jesus" (Phil. 1:6).
 - ii. However, it is essential for us to *cooperate* with the Holy Spirit! Jesus said, Luke 13:24

"<u>Strive to enter</u> through the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able."

c. <u>God Deserves All Our Praise</u>: Try to identify EVERY GOOD THING IN YOUR LIFE. <u>Where did</u> <u>each thing come from</u>? The Bible says: "Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights..." (James 1:17).

Let Us Pray: Dear Father in heaven, thank You for blessing us in countless ways! Now, as we await Jesus' return, help us to ⇒hold loosely the things of this temporary life and ⇒increase our grip on eternal things, namely, Your Son, Your word, our holy living, and our spiritual concern for others!
