## Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart

Text: LSB 806; 2 Corinthians 9:15; 12:9-10; 8:9 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Tomorrow is our National Day of Thanksgiving — to ₱remember God's past and present blessings and ₱give Him thanks!

This is the beginning of George Washington's Thanksgiving Proclamation made on October 3, 1789: Whereas it is the duty of all Nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey his will, [and] to be grateful for his benefits... I "recommend to the People of the United States a day of public thanksgiving and prayer to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many signal favors of Almighty God..."¹ We used to be a thankful nation. May the LORD ▶enable us to see His blessings and ▶move us to give Him thanks!

We now turn our attention to the hymn, **Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart**:

1. Give Thanks: Give thanks with a grateful heart, Give thanks to the Holy One, Give thanks because He's given Jesus Christ His Son. // Those words are based on 2 Corinthians 9:15 "Thanks be to God for His

indescribable gift!" // God has given us countless gifts, BUT the gift that is BY FAR the GREATEST GIFT is the gift of His Son, who is Jesus, the Christ:

- a. A naked man needs clothes.
- b. A hungry man needs food.
- c. A fallen man needs the Savior: Not all are naked and hungry, <u>but all are fallen</u>, so this is **GREAT NEWS**: **John 3:16** "...God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."
- 2. How Can the Weak Say I am Strong? And now let the weak say, "I am strong," [WHY?] Because of what the Lord has done for us. // Those words are based on 2 Corinthians 12:9-10. When Paul was suffering with "a thorn in the flesh," Jesus said to Paul: "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." [Then Paul commented:] "Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. Therefore, I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong." // Do you get it?
  - a. When we think we are strong we are trusting in ourselves. Therefore, it's better to know we are weak AND TRUST IN JESUS, because then we will be strong through Him!
  - b. Paul wrote: **Philippians 4:13** "I can do all things through Him [Christ] who strengthens me."

- 3. How Can the Poor Say I am Rich? Let the poor say, "I am rich," [WHY?] Because of what the Lord has done for us. // Those words are based on 2 Corinthians 8:9 "...you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich." // Think about that:
  - a. Jesus loves us **SO MUCH** that He ▶left the glory of heaven, ▶put on human flesh, and ▶lived a sinless life as our sinless substitute!
  - b. And then, during His final 24 hours, He permitted Himself to be †arrested, †tried, †condemned, †beaten, and †crucified.
  - c. And then, when His saving work was finished,
     ⇒ He laid down His life! Jesus became a condemned and crucified criminal for us, so that we could forever enjoy the riches of heaven!

Conclusion: Give thanks, give thanks. // Yes, moment-by-moment, day-by-day, let us keep ⇒expressing our thanks to our GREAT GOD and ⇒living lives of thanksgiving!

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, You have taken away our sins, You make us strong, and You have promised us eternal riches, so, let us and all believers KEEP GIVING YOU THANKS!
