Who Is Jesus? Are You Sure?

Text: Luke 7:18-28 NAS 1995

Advent Wednesdays: Service 11, Meal 12 | Meal 6, Service 7

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Think about people you know who do <u>not</u> follow Jesus... For one reason or another, they are *uninterested or *hesitant. Why? Because they are unsure about who Jesus is - Creator, Lamb of God, the ONLY WAY to Heaven! Some who followed John the Baptizer were in that same category - UNSURE ABOUT WHO JESUS IS! Let's see *how John helped his followers and *how we could help people who are <u>not</u> currently following Jesus.

1. Background Information about John the Baptizer and His Followers:

- a. Isaiah wrote about John, 700 years before his birth.
- b. God sent John to prepare the way for Jesus.
- c. John <u>lived</u>, <u>preached</u>, and <u>baptized</u> in the wilderness, and multitudes came to him.
- d. John had followers who learned from him and tried to follow what he taught.
- e. When John identified Jesus as "the Lamb of God" (John 1:36), two of John's disciples, *Andrew* (*Peter's brother*) and John, began to follow Jesus (John 1:37).

- f. In the following months, John was *arrested and *put in prison. However, John still had loyal followers who were unwilling to begin to follow Jesus. Why? They were UNSURE ABOUT WHO JESUS IS!
- 2. Leading Up to Today's Gospel Reading: As recorded earlier in Luke chapter 7:
 - a. <u>Jesus Healed a Centurion's Servant</u> simply by saying "the word" (7).
 - b. <u>Jesus Raised the Only Son of a Widow</u>. The Bible says that Jesus "came up and touched the coffin; and the bearers came to a halt. And He said, 'Young man, I say to you, arise!' The dead man sat up and began to speak... This report concerning Him went out all over Judea and in all the surrounding district" (14-15, 17).
- 3. John's Plan to Point His Followers to Jesus: 18 The disciples of John reported to him about all these things [healing the sick and raising the dead]. 19 Summoning two of his disciples, John sent them to the Lord, saying, "Are You the Expected One [the Messiah], or do we look for someone else?" // The answer was not for John's benefit. John had already proclaimed Jesus to be "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29). John also said about Jesus, "He must increase, but I must decrease" (Jn. 3:30). Therefore, the answer was intended to help his remaining followers *become SURE ABOUT WHO JESUS IS and *follow Jesus.
- 4. John's Followers Question Jesus: ²⁰ When the men came to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, to ask, 'Are You the Expected One, or do we look for

- **someone else?"** // Jesus could have said, "Yes," but we know that ACTIONS speak **much louder** than words!
- 5. Jesus' POWERFUL Answer: ²¹ At that very time He cured many people of diseases and afflictions and evil spirits; and He gave sight to many who were blind. // WOW, WOW, WOW!!! Many immediate cures! Many evil spirits cast out! Many blind people were given sight!
- 6. Give this Report to John: ²² And He answered and said to them, "Go and report to John what you have <u>seen</u> and <u>heard</u>: the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the POOR HAVE THE GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM. ²³ Blessed is he who does not take offense at Me."
 - a. The OT Promise: When the Messiah comes: Isaiah
 35:5-6 "Then the eyes of the blind will be opened,
 And the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Then the
 lame will leap like a deer, And the tongue of the mute
 will shout for joy."
 - b. <u>The Eyewitness Fulfillment</u>: John's followers **saw** *with their own eyes* and **heard** *with their own ears!*
 - c. John and Jesus were Different: Jesus made this comparison: "...John the Baptist has come eating no bread and drinking no wine, and you say, 'He has a demon!' The Son of Man has come eating and drinking, and you say, 'Behold, a gluttonous man and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!'" (Luke 7:33-34). The differences may have caused some to take offense at Jesus, but BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO DO NOT!

- 7. Let Me Tell You about John: ²⁴ When the messengers of John had left, [Jesus] began to speak to the crowds about John, "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind [a man wavering on the truth]?

 ²⁵ But what did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft clothing [John was the opposite]? Those who are splendidly clothed and live in luxury are found in royal palaces!

 ²⁶ But what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I say to you, and one who is more than a prophet. ²⁷ This is the one about whom it is written, 'BEHOLD, I SEND MY MESSENGER AHEAD OF YOU, WHO WILL PREPARE YOUR WAY BEFORE YOU.' ²⁸ I say to you, among those born of women there is no one greater than John; yet he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."
 - a. What Described John the Baptizer? Firm on God's word no compromise!
 - b. <u>How Great was John the Baptizer</u>? **He** *was written about by Isaiah, *was the last OT prophet, *prepared the way for Jesus, and *baptized Jesus!
 - c. <u>How Much Greater is Kingdom Membership</u>? Those beyond John ♦know of Jesus' death, resurrection, and ascension, and ♦have the Holy Spirit living in them!

Conclusion: How can we encourage others to begin following Jesus? Let us help them be sure ABOUT WHO JESUS IS!
