

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: This is Part 5 of a 6-Part sermon series on The 12 Days of Christmas. Some of you have heard each part of the series: Thanks for being faithful! For Others, Here Is Some Basic Information:

- Which 12 Days? December 25 through January 5.
 - Why the Song? Due to severe persecution, it was written as a poem in 1558 to disguise important Bible teachings. It was set to music in 1909.
 - Who are the Singers? The singers are people who trust in Jesus for eternal life. They sing about the goodness of their *True Love*, *God the Father*, because He has gifted them with *12 precious Bible-related gifts*.
 - In this Series: We are moving from gift 12 to gift 1.

These are the Gifts We have Covered So Far:

 Day 12 – Twelve Drummers Drumming, which point to The 12 points of belief in the Apostles' Creed.

- Day 11 Eleven Pipers Piping, which point to The 11 faithful disciples.
- Day 10 Ten Lords A-Leaping, which point to The 10 Commandments.
- Day 9 Nine Ladies Dancing, which point to The 9 Parts of the Fruit of the Spirit.
- Day 8 Eight Maids A-Milking, which point to The 8 Beatitudes, which begin the Sermon on the Mount.
- Day 7 Seven Swans A-Swimming, which point to The 7 Gifts of the Spirit.
- Day 6 Six Geese A-Laying, which point to The 6 Days of Creation.
- Day 5 Five Golden Rings, which point to The First 5 Books of the Bible.

<u>Today</u>: We focus on Days 4 & 3; <u>tomorrow</u>, Days 2 & 1.

- Day 4 Four Calling Birds: The Four Gospel Accounts Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. They called out to the world with the soul-saving truth of Jesus!
 - a. <u>A Summary</u>: Moved by the Holy Spirit (2 Peter 1:21), each Gospel writer wrote about Jesus'
 *life, *death, *resurrection, and *return!
 - i. <u>Jesus' Life</u> *living without sin for us!*
 - ii. <u>Jesus' Death</u> paying our eternal penalty!
 - iii. <u>Jesus' Resurrection</u> showing His victory!
 - iv. <u>Jesus' Return</u> Since he could come at any moment, it is of UTMOST IMPORTANCE to
 ▶recognize our helplessness, ▶trust in Jesus'

alone for heaven, and put Him first in our daily lives!

- b. The Audience of Each Writer (Google AI):
 - i. Matthew "Written for Jewish people..."
 - ii. Mark "Written for... Gentiles..."
 - iii. Luke "Written for Greeks..."
 - iv. John "Written for everyone..."
- c. The Purpose of All Four Accounts: John 20:31

 "...these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name." // God's Son came down from heaven and put on human flesh; at Christmastime we celebrate His birthday. But that is NOT the end of the story: He was born TO DIE for you and me!

 Let us *love Him, *trust Him, and *honor Him!
- 2. Day 3 Three French Hens: The Three Great Blessings Faith, Hope, and Love.
 - a. Faith Is trust in Jesus for eternal life!
 - b. <u>Hope</u> Is certainty that God will fulfill every promise!
 - c. <u>Love</u> Is what believers show toward God and others, now and forever!
 - d. The Bible Says: 1 Corinthians 13:13 ... now faith, hope, love, abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love. // Why is love the greatest?
 - i. Faith is temporary until we SEE Jesus!

- ii. **Hope is temporary** until God's last promise is FULFILLED!
- iii. But love is eternal as ♥God keeps showering His love upon us – His holy children, and ♥we keep showing true love toward God and each other forevermore!
