

Introduction: Are YOU ready – *RIGHT NOW* – to meet Jesus? If you said, "Yes," you are like the ten virgins who were waiting for the bridegroom. *They all THOUGHT they were ready*. Let's see if they were ready as we read through Jesus' parable of the ten virgins.

1. <u>Ready or Not!</u> Jesus said these words on Tuesday of Holy Week, a few days before He completed His work to take away the sin of the world: ¹ "Then the kingdom of heaven will be comparable to ten virgins [young unmarried women], who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ² Five of them were <u>foolish</u> [having little sense], and five were <u>prudent</u> [using their wits effectively]. ³ For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, ⁴ but the prudent took oil in flasks along with their lamps." // Keep in mind that the Bible uses this symbolism: Jesus is the groom, and the believers are His bride. He will return at an **unexpected time** to take the believers to His Father's house to celebrate the wedding feast. In the parable, all ten virgins **thought** they were ****Christians and ****ready for Jesus' return.

- a. <u>They All Looked Good</u>: Each one was carrying a lamp. Here at Bethlehem, we have 205 souls on our membership list. It looks good to be on the BLC list, but it doesn't mean such people are ready! Are YOU ready to meet Jesus?
- b. <u>Only Five were Ready</u>: The five not only had a lamp, but they also had the oil needed to power the lamp. <u>What is Christian oil</u>? It's those vital unseen gifts of God, like:
 - i. Faith in Jesus!
 - ii. The forgiveness of sins!
 - iii. The clothing of righteousness!
 - iv. The gift of eternal life!
 - v. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit!

When those gifts are present on the inside, *they* will show in word and deed!

2. Each Person Is Responsible for Being Ready! ⁵ "Now while the bridegroom was delaying [see 2 Peter 3:9], they all got drowsy and began to sleep. ⁶ But at midnight there was a shout, 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' ⁷ Then all those virgins rose and trimmed their lamps. ⁸ The foolish said to the prudent, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' ⁹ But the prudent answered, 'No, there will not be enough for us and you too; go instead to the dealers and buy some for yourselves.'"

- a. <u>The Foolish were Not Ready</u>: They were lacking oil; in other words, *they were lacking these gifts of God*: *faith, *forgiveness, *righteousness, *eternal life, and *the Holy Spirit.
- b. <u>The Gifts of God are Free</u>: They are free because **JESUS** paid the price **IN FULL**!
- c. <u>How are those gifts received</u>? As the Holy Spirit (*working through baptism and the God's word*) moves people to repent and believe!
- d. We Cannot Save Other People: In Ezekiel 14, the LORD described certain tragic situations that He could bring upon the nation of Israel. Then He said, Ezekiel 14:20 "...even though Noah, Daniel and Job were in its midst, as I live," declares the Lord GOD, "they could not deliver either their son or their daughter. They would deliver only themselves by their righteousness." // So, each person is being called to *repent of his sins and *trust in Jesus for eternal life! Are YOU ready to meet Jesus?
- 3. No Second Chances! ¹⁰ "And while they were going away to make the purchase, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was <u>shut</u> [locked, barred]. ¹¹ Later the other virgins also came, saying, 'Lord, lord, <u>open up</u> [give access] for us.' ¹² But he answered, 'Truly I say to you, I do <u>not know you</u> [not have a close relationship with you].'"
 - a. <u>Time Is Running Out for 2024</u>: We are now in the final hours of 2024. At midnight on January 1,

2024, this year was like a wide-open door, *but immediately it started to close*. Very soon it will be shut and locked, *and never opened again!*

- b. Time Is Running Out for Knowing Jesus:
 - i. **He wants us to be ready** with godly sorrow and trust in Him alone for heaven!
 - ii. He wants to know us now <u>listening</u> to Him, <u>following</u> Him, <u>learning</u> from Him, and <u>living</u> for Him!
 - iii. He wants to welcome us in when He arrives! Are YOU ready to meet Jesus?
- Always Be Ready! ¹³ "Be on the alert [keep awake, be watchful] then, for you do not know the day nor the hour."
 - a. <u>Whenever we have something coming up in our</u> <u>lives</u>: We know WHEN, so we plan to be ready at that time! However, when we don't know WHEN, then we only have one good choice: ALWAYS BE READY!
 - b. What about you: Are YOU ready to meet Jesus?

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, we are certain You will return, but we don't know when. Therefore, dear Holy Spirit, make us ready and always keep us ready, so that Jesus will welcome us in when He arrives!
