13: What Kind of Faith Saves?

- Not this kind: James 2:17 "Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself." // That refers to someone who merely SAYS he has faith (when a person has faith in Jesus for eternal life, it will show).
- Notice the difference: Romans 4:4-5
 - 4:4: "Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due." // When you are employed and do your work, your paycheck is not a favor but what you earned.
 - 4:5: "But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness..."
 - What does it mean to be JUSTIFIED? God sees me JUST [as] IF I'D never sinned!
 - By God's grace, we have stopped trying to work our way into heaven!
 - By God's grace, we believe in God and Jesus, and have been declared righteous!

14: Can Good Works Help Us?

- Faith and works MUST be kept separate: Romans 3:28 "...we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law." // As Christians, we have faith and works, BUT we are JUSTIFIED by FAITH ALONE!
- Adding our works to Jesus' work is extremely negative: Galatians 5:4 "You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law [by adding your work to Jesus' work]; you have fallen from grace." // Whenever we add to Jesus' work, we are essentially

- saying that He did NOT do enough. Let us be CERTAIN that HIS WORK is ALL SUFFICIENT to save us!
- Notice the basis upon which we are saved: Titus 3:5 "[God] saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy..." // God, through JESUS ALONE, spares us from eternal punishment:)

15: How We Are Saved!

God works through <u>baptism</u> (Acts 2:38-39) and <u>the Bible</u> (1 Peter 1:23) to give us His righteousness!

- God shows us our lost condition and makes us sorry for our sins: 2 Cor. 7:10 "...the sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation..." // A person says: I'm *sorry for my sins, *helpless to save myself, and *open to Jesus!
- God gives us His righteousness in Christ: 2 Cor. 5:21
 "He [G the F] made Him [the Christ] who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him [Jesus]." // Jesus received our sin and punishment; we, by faith, received God's righteousness the exact thing we need for heaven!
- God gives assurance: 1 John 5:13 "These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life."

16: How We Live as Disciples!

- Growing through God's word: Acts 20:32 "...I commend you to... the word of His grace, which is able to build you up..." // Be faithful in *attending divine service and *reading, living, and sharing God's word!
- Receiving God's gifts: Hebrews 10:25 "...not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some..." // Gladly attend, receive, and benefit!
- Living for Christ: 2 Cor. 5:15 "...He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf." // Jesus lived and died for us, so let us live for Him!
- Supporting God's work: Proverbs 3:9-10 "Honor the LORD from your wealth And from the first of all your produce; So your barns will be filled with plenty And your vats will overflow with new wine." // As we honor the LORD from the first, He will abundantly bless us!
