

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: He is risen! (He is risen indeed! Alleluia!) Jesus being risen is powerful and amazing:

- Some believe and are richly blessed!
- Others need today's gospel reading about Thomas!
- The Resurrected Jesus: ¹⁹ When therefore it was evening [just before sundown], on that day [Sunday], the first day of the week [the day Jesus was raised], and when the doors were shut [locked, barred] where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you." ²⁰ And when He had said this, He showed them both His hands and His side. The disciples therefore rejoiced when they saw the Lord.
 - a. <u>Are You Living In Fear</u>? Going back to that first Easter Sunday, *the fearful disciples were behind locked doors*. <u>Why</u>? They naturally thought: Jesus has been crucified, *and we might be next*!
 - b. <u>Why Should We Be at Peace</u>? *Because God is greater than death!* Since Jesus died and was raised, we should live with <u>no fear of death</u> – *because death is not the end!* When Jesus comes, *He will raise us!*

- 2. Instruction, Forgiveness, and Unbelief: ²¹ Jesus therefore said to them again, "Peace *be* with you; as the Father has sent Me, <u>I also send you</u>." ²² And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. ²³ <u>If you forgive</u> the sins of any, *their sins* have been forgiven them; <u>if you retain</u> the *sins* of any, they have been retained." ²⁴ But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.
 ²⁵ The other disciples therefore were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "<u>Unless I shall see</u> in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, <u>I will not believe</u>."
 - a. Are You Living with Purpose?
 - i. **The Father** sent the Son to take away our sins.
 - ii. ⇒The Son sent the Apostles to call people to repent and believe.
 - iii. →The HS is calling us to point to our great God, who changed our next stop from hell to heaven!
 - b. <u>Can We Announce and Withhold God's Forgiveness</u>? Yes! **Lenski noted these key points** (1377-1378):
 - i. Jesus gave all His disciples the power of the keys – not only the ten (the 12 minus Judas and Thomas). The power can be used **privately** by all Christians and **publicly** by pastors in their congregations.
 - ii. Jesus forgives, *not people*, but Jesus' disciples are His agents – *He acts through them*.
 - iii. Since we cannot see into a person's heart, we must consider +what he <u>says</u> and +what he <u>does</u>.

- c. <u>What Is Faith</u>? **Hebrews 11:1** "...faith is... the <u>conviction</u> [confident assurance] of things <u>not</u> seen."
- 3. Blessed Ones: ²⁶ And after <u>eight days</u> [Sunday to Sunday] again His disciples were inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst, and said, "Peace be with you." ²⁷ Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand, and put it into My side; and be not unbelieving, but believing." ²⁸ Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!" ²⁹ Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed."
 - a. <u>Thomas Demanded Visible Proof</u>: So, Jesus provided it for him. Thomas is the go-to example today for all who demand visible proof. May such people *put on the shoes of Thomas, *see the risen Jesus by faith, and *believe in Him as *their Lord* and *their God*!
 - b. <u>Have you seen Jesus</u>? I have not, <u>yet</u> by the grace of God and the work of the Holy Spirit – <u>I believe</u>! People who have <u>not</u> seen and <u>yet</u> believe are richly blessed! <u>If that is **not** you</u>, get into the Bible in a serious way and the Holy Spirit with gift you with saving faith!
- 4. Keep the Main Thing the Main Thing: ³⁰ Many other signs therefore Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these have been written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name. // Life can be so busy and so complicated, but let's keep the main thing the main thing.

- a. <u>Believe Jesus Is the Christ</u>: "Christ" means "Messiah" and "Anointed One" – He:
 - i. Was promised in Eden!
 - ii. Guided by a pillar of fire and of cloud!
 - iii. Appeared many times as the Angel of the Lord!
 - iv. Was born of a virgin!
 - v. Taught with authority!
 - vi. Worked countless miracles!
 - vii. Suffered and died to pay our eternal penalty!
 - viii. Now lives forevermore!

b. Have Life Eternal through Jesus:

- i. <u>We Know the Bad News</u>: We ◆have sinned and
 ◆are helpless to save ourselves.
- We Focus on the Good News: Jesus is the Christ, the only way to the Father, so, by God's grace,
 ♦we trust in Him alone, ♦we have eternal life now, ♦we live in peace, and ♦we look forward to an amazing eternity!

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, *our Risen Savior*, of all the people and all things in this complex world that draw our attention, *You are infinitely more important!* Therefore, help us to *put You first, *trust You most, and *tell others what You have done!
