## Welcome to My World

Many years ago, I \*faithfully attended church and Bible Class, \*served as an usher, and \*thought I was a Christian.

Then, in my later 20's – by the Holy Spirit working through the Bible, my trust was transferred **from** myself **to** Jesus.

Then, as the months went by, I became more open to God's plan for my life – **never** imagining it would lead to serving as a pastor, a shepherd. // **Ephesians 3:20** "Now to [God] who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us..."

## The Ultimate Shepherd and The Under-Shepherd

Jesus is the **Ultimate Shepherd** – perfect in every way, but I am an **under-shepherd** serving under Jesus. I cannot live without sin, but – by God's grace – I am a repentant and forgiven child of God! It is my greatest desire for <u>us</u> to be with God forevermore!

**Since Jesus' return is drawing closer every moment**, it is critical for us to be ready:

- 1 Thessalonians 5:2 "...the Lord will come just like a thief in the night."
- Mark 13:33 "Take heed, keep on the alert; for you do not know when the appointed time will come."

### Difficult for Me - Good for You

Shepherds should be diligent to rightly and fully know, live, and teach God's word:

Be Accurate – James 3:1 Let not many of you become
 [Bible] teachers, my brethren, knowing that as such we

- will incur a stricter judgment. // All pastors / undershepherds should be as hardworking as possible to rightly handle God's word of truth!
- Warn Unrepentant Ones Ezekiel 3:18 "When I [the LORD] say to the wicked [unrepentant man], 'You will surely die,' and you [Ezekiel a speaker of My word] do not warn him or speak out to warn the wicked from his wicked way that he may live, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand [Kretzmann: "as having caused the slaughter of an immortal soul by his negligence.]." // Warning unrepentant ones is DIFFICULT because they think they are fine, but IMPORTANT because they will perish without repentance.
- Identify Sin Galatians 5:19-21 "...the deeds of the flesh are evident:
  - [Lust and sex outside of marriage]: immorality, impurity, sensuality,
  - [Sins related to godlessness]: <u>idolatry</u> [idol worship], sorcery,
  - [Sins related to personal hatred]: enmities [hostilities], strife [discord], jealousy, outbursts of anger,
  - [Sins related to taking sides]: <u>disputes</u>, <u>dissensions</u>
     [divisions], <u>factions</u> [sects], <u>envying</u>,
  - [Sins related to partying]: <u>drunkenness</u>, <u>carousing</u> and things like these... those who <u>practice</u> [do, commit] such things will <u>not</u> inherit the kingdom of God.
- Tell the Full Truth Acts 20:26-27 [Paul said to pastors he had trained:] ...I am innocent of the blood of all men. [Why?] For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God." // It is vital for all shepherds to

teach God's full truth and vital for all people to faithfully

♦hear, ♦understand, ♦believe, and ♦apply!
