A Good Way to Begin Our Prayers (note a-c-t-s; use all or part of this section):

- 1. **Dear God:** I <u>adore</u> you for being eternal, unchangeable, all-powerful, allknowing, present everywhere, holy, just, faithful, good, merciful, and gracious (Luther's Small Catechism, 105-107)!
- 2. I <u>confess</u> that I have sinned against You and others *in* my thoughts, *by* my words, and *with* my deeds; I have fallen far short of Your will for my life; please forgive me (Rom. 3:10; 3:20; 3:23; 1 John 1:9)!
- I <u>thank</u> You ◆for creating me and loving me, ◆for sending Your Son to take my sins and my punishment, ◆for Your wonderful gift of forgiveness through Jesus, and ◆for providing all that I need (Acts 17:24-31; John 3:16; Isaiah 53:4-10; Acts 24:46-47; 1 John 1:7; Rom. 8:32; Phil. 4:19)!
- Please <u>supply</u> me with ◆love for Your Holy Word, ◆strength to put off my old self and put on my new self, ◆concern for the needs of all people, and ◆desire to glorify You in all I say and do (Ps. 143:8; Eph. 4:22-24; Mark 12:28-31; Matt. 5:16; 1 Cor. 10:31)!
