OT INSTRUCTION: Ezekiel 3:16-21 NIV – Called servants of God must warn the wicked!

¹⁶ At the end of seven days the word of the LORD came to me: ¹⁷ "Son of man, I have made you a <u>watchman</u> for the house of Israel; so <u>hear</u> <u>the word I speak</u> and <u>give them warning from me</u>.

If you DO NOT warn the wicked: ¹⁸ When I say to a wicked man, 'You will surely die,' and you <u>do not warn him</u> or speak out to dissuade him from his evil ways in order to save his life, that wicked man will die for his sin, and <u>I will hold you</u> accountable for his blood.

If you DO warn the wicked: ¹⁹ But if you <u>do</u> <u>warn the wicked</u> man and he does not turn from his wickedness or from his evil ways, he will die for his sin; but <u>you will have saved yourself</u>.

If you DO NOT warn the wicked: ²⁰ Again, when a righteous man turns from his

righteousness and does evil, and I put a stumbling block before him, he will die. <u>Since you did not</u> <u>warn him, he will die for his sin</u>. The righteous things he did will not be remembered, and <u>I will</u> <u>hold you accountable for his blood</u>. If you DO warn the wicked: ²¹ But if you <u>do</u> warn the righteous man not to sin and he does not sin, he will surely live because he took warning, and <u>you will have saved yourself</u>." L: The Word of the Lord.

NT LETTER (Epistle): Romans 10:8b-18 NIV – Andrew had beautiful feet!

⁸⁶ "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: ⁹ That <u>if you confess with your</u> <u>mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart</u> <u>that God raised him from the dead, you will be</u> <u>saved</u>. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. ¹¹ As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile--the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for, "<u>Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will</u> be saved."

¹⁴ <u>How, then, can they call</u> on the one they have not believed in? And <u>how can they believe</u> in the one of whom they have not heard? And <u>how can they hear</u> without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And <u>how can they preach</u> unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

(**A**arise) HYMN VERSE: " By All Your Saints in Warfare"

 All praise, O Lord, for Andrew, The first to welcome You,
 Whose witness to his brother Named You Messiah true. ¹⁶ But not all the Israelites accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our message?" ¹⁷ Consequently, <u>faith comes from hearing the message</u>, and the message is heard through the word of Christ. ¹⁸ But I ask: Did they not hear? Of course they did: "<u>Their voice has</u> <u>gone out into all the earth</u>, their words to the ends of the world."

May we, with hearts kept open To You throughout the year, Confess to friend and neighbor Your advent ever near. GOOD NEWS (Gospel) (LSB 190-191): John 1:35-42a NIV – Andrew heard, followed, and told!

L: The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the first chapter.

C: (sung) Glory be to Thee, O Lord!

³⁵ The next day John [the Baptizer] was there again with **two of his disciples**. ³⁶ When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" ³⁷ When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?" ³⁹ "Come," he replied, "and you will see." So they went and saw where he was staying, and spent that day with him. It was about the tenth hour [probably 10 AM, since John seems to use Roman time]. ⁴⁰ Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. ⁴¹ <u>The first thing Andrew did</u> was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). ⁴² And he brought him to Jesus.
